March the middle part of this day light winds and pleasant weather at 6 AM fair in large shoal of Whales board caught nothing. Stillham's Employed in Ship Duty and fishing the coast for Whaling Lat 46:11 Longi 80:00

March Sunday 4

Thursday Commences with calm the middle part light wind from north east the middle part calm the latter part light wind from north east a grate number of Porpoises. Lat 45:42 Longi 86:00 Longi 82:50

March Monday 5

Friday Commences with fine pleasant weather. Light Wind from north at 6 AM kept the Main top sail at 6 AM Double reefed the top sails at 8 AM put the Main sail. Put the Main stay sail to the rig at the foremast. Cleared the top sails and kept the fore sail at 6 AM put the fore and Main top sails at 8 AM. Bore ship to the North East the Wind from the West attended with rain. Lat 45:20 Longi 83:51

March Tuesday 6

Saturday Commences with strong Breezes from West attended with rain at 2 PM Made all sail. Put the fore top Mast bearing sail at 6 PM the Wind at South West. all this day Light Breezes with Light squalls from the Watch Employed in Ship Duty Lat 43:10 Longi 83:51

March Wednesday 7

Sunday Commences with Light breezes from South at 2 PM put the bearing sail on the Harbour side at 6 PM put the Main sail the middle part this day strong Wind and light squalls of rain the latter part strong Wind and clear the Wind at South. Lat 41:05 Longi 83:20

March Thursday 8

Monday Commences with strong Wind from South and clear the middle part light Wind and variable the latter part calm and pleasant weather. Stillham's Employed in getting up Water out the lower Hoab forward on the Harbour side Lat 39:30 Longi 83:10 = 150 Days

March Friday 9

Tuesday Commences with a calm at 12 at night light Wind at north West Bore the gear's to the bearing sail. the Wind light the weather pleasant. All sail put. the middle part calm the latter part light Wind from north West this day fished our cutting Benants and put them up. this day gave a grate number of Porpoises and black fish. Stillham's Employed in Ship Duty. Lat 39:14 Longi 83:00

March Saturday 10

Wednesday Commences with light Wind from north West and pleasant the middle part the same the latter part more Wind from the same quarter stillham's Employed in Ship Duty Lat 39:00 Longi 82:50

March Sunday 11

Thursday Commences with brisk breeze from West North West and pleasant the middle part the same the latter part light squalls of rain and strong Wind. Lat 38:44 Longi 82:25

March Monday 12

the first part of this day strong Wind from West the middle part from South West latter part from South at 4 PM put the bearing sail on the Harbour side at 6 AM put the Main sail of Massachusetts the latter part of this day 33:45 South Longi 80:35 West Longi 80:00

March Tuesday 13

Wednesday Commences with strong Wind from South at 2 PM put the Boat on shore and a g. fishing at 6 PM the boat returned with a boat 80 fish at the same time put the Main sail Double reefed the top sails and spoke the ship Foster of Sandwich 22 months out with 2200 Bbls of oil. this ship had 100 thought was Massachusetts bound to be the name of Swanfer named Lat 33:45 South Longi 79:06 at 8 AM put the Boat on shore for wood at 12 at noon came of with Beaches and fish Lat 33:45 Longi 79:06

March Wednesday 14

Thursday Commences with strong Wind from South East at 6 PM wore ship and flew to the Eastward at 12 at night wore ship to the Westward at 8 AM put the Boat on shore for Beaches at 12 at noon came of with about 10 Bushels of Beaches. the Boat returned at Lat 33:45 Longi 79:06

March Thursday 15

Friday Commences with strong Wind from South at 2 PM wore ship flew to the East Ward at 8 PM put the gill and plank at 10 PM put the Main and Main stay sails the middle part strong Wind and squall this night put the Beaches 4 Batches latter part strong Wind and clear put forward Main top gallant. Mast Lat 33:00 Longi 77:50
