April Sunday 5
 This day commences with Light Winds from North and Pleasant at 4 P.M. gave a Brig Hearing North West. the Schooner in sight the Middle part Light Winds and Clear and Pleasant. furl'd the top gallant sails. latter part fresh Breezes from North Lat 27:55 Long 71:30

April Monday 9
 This day commences with Light Winds from West Clear and Pleasant at 6 P.M. furl'd the fore and Main top gallant sails. the Middle part Light squalls of Wind and heavy rain. the latter part the Wind from North. All hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 27:20 Long 72:30

April Tuesday 10
 This day commences with strong Winds from North at Noon tack'd ship to East & East. at 4 Double Reef'd the top sails. this day Mend'd the sprinker and Berret and Bent the Middle part strong Wind latter part more Moderate. Mend'd the Main top sail All hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 26:38 Long 72:40

April Wednesday 11
 This day commences with Light Winds from North and Clear gave quite number of Dolphin. at 2 P.M. anchor'd the Main top sail and Bent the other. the Middle part Calm the latter part strong Wind from South East at 6 P.M. gave a school of Black fish all hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 25:39 Long 72:50

April Thursday 12
 This day commences with strong Wind from South East. at 6 P.M. furl'd the Main top sail and Double Reef'd the fore and Main top sail. furl'd the sprinker. at 8 P.M. put the Main top sail Eastward Reef'd the Main top sail put the fore Main top gallant sail. All hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 23:50 Long 72:30

April Friday 13
 This day commences with strong Wind from South East at 6 P.M. furl'd the Main top gallant sail Double Reef'd the Main top sail

 This day commences with Light Wind from South East at 6 P.M. spoke the ship young Phoenix of New Bedford. Mass. all well. the Middle part of Light Wind. latter part chose brisk from South East all hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 21:40 Long 71:20

April Wednesday 18
 This day commences with strong trades and Pleasant. the young Phoenix in company. the Middle part Light Wind from South East. latter part strong Wind and Clear. all hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 20:50 the Land in sight.

April Thursday 19
 This day commences with strong trades and Pleasant the young Phoenix in company. the Middle part fresh Wind the latter part the same all hands imploy'd in ship's Duty Lat 19:35 Long 71:30
