Heard ship to the south West at 10 PM. Wore ship to the East. Light wind at 6 AM. Set all sail. all hands employed in ships Duty
Lat 12° 19' Long 79° 18'

May Friday 4

This Day Commences with strong trades and cloudy at 2 PM. Caught a seal at the same time first the top gallant jacks and Jan 8 sails. Steaming to the North at 6 PM. Set all sail except the top sails. at night steamed to the South West. the Middle part calm and thick and cloudy Jan 8 sails steaming. with all hands employed in ships Duty
Land in sight

May Saturday 5

This Day Commences with calm at 2 PM. gave a breach. supposed to be a sperm whale. he leaved the boat and gave nothing at 6 PM. Light wind from South East. steamed South West under 3 top sails. Main top gallant sail and gib. at 12 at night light wind from South East at 6 AM. Set all sail the latter part the Day. Steamed West all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 12° 45' Long 78° 40'

May Sunday 6

This Day Commences with brisk trades and clear at 6 AM. took in all sail. Except 3 top sail steaming South West. at 6 PM. got all sail. Steamed West gave pleasant weather gave fresh back
Lat 12° 19' Land in sight

May Monday 7

This Day Commences with strong trades and clear at 6 AM. furl all sail except the top sails. Steamed West by South at 6 PM. got fore sail. Main top gallant sail. at the same time gave a Spanish ship. spoke the Jativa of Mantivet. later part strong winds. all hands employed in ships Duty
Lat 12° 19' Long 79° 00'

May Tuesday 8

This Day Commences with strong trades at 6 AM. took in sail at 9 AM. left the Jativa. She had 1-50 barrels & Monies out. the latter part strong winds at 6 PM. Steamed North West at 10 PM. gave King. Steaming South all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 10° 40' Long 79° 30'

May Wednesday 9

This Day Commences with strong winds and cloudy at 6 PM. furl the Main top gallant sail. kept the fore and Main top sail. took in the fore sail. at 6 PM. gave the ship to the Wind the Middle part More moderate at 6 PM. got the Main top gallant sail and gib. steamed to the North East at 10 PM. gave a Spanish Boat. strong winds and cloudy all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 10° 25' Long 79° 15'

May Thursday 10

This Day Commences with strong trades at 6 PM. furl the gib and Main top gallant sail. fore and Main top sail. Double kept the Main top sail. gave ship to the South West. at 6 PM. gave ship to the North East. at the same time got the fore and Main top sail all this Day. strong winds and clear weather all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 10° 15' Long 78° 50'

May Friday 11

This Day Commences with strong wind and clear at 6 PM. Wore ship to the South under Double keels. at 12 at night wore ship to the North East. at 6 PM. got the gib at 10 PM. gave the young Phoenix from Lima. latter part of the Day strong winds all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 9° 44' Long 79° 40'

May Saturday 12

This Day Commences with strong trades at 6 PM. furl the Main top gallant sail. at night wore ship to the North West. the young Phoenix in company. at 6 PM. got the Main top gallant sail and gib. all this Day. strong wind all hands employed in ships Duty. Lat 7° 59' Long 79° 40'

May Sunday 13

This Day Commences with strong trades at 6 PM. furl the Main top gallant sail and gib. at the same time steamed to the North West. the young Phoenix in company. at 6 PM. gave a ship steaming North West. at the same time got all sail the latter part More moderate. Lat 6° 37' Land in sight.

May Monday 14

This Day Commences with Moderate breezes and cloudy at 5 PM. gave 2 large sperm whales. at 7 PM. furl all sail except the 3 top sail. at night steamed to South West.
