

Ship *Phoebe Ann*. New Bedford 1827

Friday 25

This day commences with light winds and cloudy at 4 P.M. tack ship to the North East at 7 P.M. wore ship to fourth West at the same time furl'd the top gallant sails and gill and Main sail. at 6 P.M. got all sail from black fish at 10 P.M. gave a Brigg steaming North East. All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 29' Land in sight.

Saturday 26

This day commences with light winds and clear at 6 P.M. furl'd the top gallant sails and flying jib and fourth West. at 6 P.M. got all sail at 10 P.M. gave black fish wore ship at the same time to the North East. All this day light winds and pleasant All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 30' Land in sight.

May Sunday 27

This day commences with light winds and pleasant gave black fish at 4 P.M. at the same time tack ship to the fourth West at 6 P.M. took in the top gallant sails and spanker Hauled the fore sail and Main sail up. at 6 P.M. got all sail at the same time wore ship to the North East gave black fish no latitude.

May Monday 28

This day commences with light winds and cloudy gave black fish at 6 P.M. took in all sail except the top sail at light tack ship to the fourth West. all this day light squalls of rain and strong winds the latter of the day all hands imploy'd in ship duty. no lat this day Longi 83° 8'

May Tuesday 29

This day commences with strong winds and light squalls rain. at 6 P.M. more moderate. the latter strong wind at 6 P.M. got the Main sail and Main top gallant sail. gave black fish All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 16' Longi 82° 40'

May Wednesday 30

This day commences with light winds and cloudy at 6 P.M. furl'd the top gallant sails. at 10 wore ship to the fourth West. at 2 P.M. wore ship to the East at 6 P.M. got all sail the wind light and cloudy at 10 P.M. gave a ship steaming East all sail set. this day got the Main Royal gear'd up. All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 17' Land in sight.

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Thursday 31

This day commences with light winds and cloudy at 8 P.M. kept of W West. at 6 P.M. hauled to the wind and furl'd the top gallant sail furl'd the top gills. at 6 P.M. got all sail. wore ship to the North West. Latter part strong winds gave grate number of black fish.

this day got a better observation found the longitude 82° 09' All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 22' Longi 82° 09'

None Friday 1

This day commences with strong wind and cloudy at 6 P.M. furl'd the top gallant sails furl'd the gill and Main sail Haul'd the fore and Mizentop sail Haul'd the fore sail up at 2 P.M. wore ship to fourth West at 6 P.M. got all sail and wore ship to the North East. All hands imploy'd in ship duty Lat 52° 31' Land in sight.

None Saturday 2

This day commences with light winds and clear at 8 P.M. spoke the sun. at the same time furl'd the light sail. at 2 P.M. wore ship to fourth West at 6 P.M. got the gill Main top gallant sail Latter part strong wind at 10 wore ship to the North East. all hands cleaning ship. Lat 52° 08' Land in sight.

None After Sunday 3

This day commences with strong winds at 6 P.M. tack ship to fourth West. at 2 P.M. tack ship to the North East. the Mizentop of this day light winds at 6 P.M. got all sail. at 8 P.M. gave 2 sails one a bag the other a catamaran. at 10 P.M. haul'd the cables and got in reeling tan Choc. Lat 52° 45' Land in sight Bayta Head bearing Ben Compa's fourth East Dist 4 leagues.

None Monday 4

This day commences with light winds all sail got at 8 P.M. tack ship to West fourth West. Bayta Head bearing Ben Compa's at 9 P.M. fourth East. Dist 4 leagues. at 10 P.M. wore ship to the East and at 2 P.M. wore ship to fourth West all sail got Lat 52° 45' Land in sight

None Tuesday 5

This day commences with light wind all sail got at 2 tack ship to fourth West at 6 P.M. furl'd the flying jib fore and Mizentop gallant sail. at 8 P.M. got all sail Latter part of this day light wind and clear All hands imploy'd in ship duty. Lat 52° 6' Longi 82° 40'
