July

Tuesday 31

This day Commences with strong wind and thick fog and rain at 6 AM tack ship to East East all sail set at 6 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sails the middle part of this day. Clear weather at 6 AM tack ship to N. West. all sail set at 10 AM tack to East by the Head bearing to Comptrols 608 Altham implorid in ship Duty Lat 5:25 Landing

August

Wednesday 1

This day Commences with light wind all sail set at 2 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sails at 4 AM furl the top sail at the same time a Brig bearing to the Eastward at 6 AM tack ship to North West by the Head in light at 11 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sails at 12 at night tack ship to the Eastward at 1 AM tack ship to North West full sail but part this day light wind

August

Thursday 2

This day Commences with moderate wind and cloudy at 4 AM untuck the Main top sail and bent another at 6 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sail. Saw black fish at 2 AM tack ship to the East at 6 AM set all sail and furl to the North West saw black fish Altham implorid in ship Duty Lat 5:11 Landing light

August

Friday 3

All this day light wind and clear saw many black fish at 6 AM tack ship to the North West at 7 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sail and flying gills the middle part light wind and clear at 6 AM set all sail later part fresh wind and cloudy Altham implorid in ship Duty Lat 5:40 Long 82:40

August

Saturday 4

This day Commences with strong wind and cloudy at 4 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sails and flying gills at the same time tack ship to the Eastward at 5 AM tack ship to North West same time furl the top sail the middle part of the day light wind and clear the latter part to Altham implorid in repairing the sails this day finished the fore sprucer and bent him Lat 5:22 land in light

August

Sunday 5

This day Commences with light wind took in sail at night saw 2 fish to the South tack ship and made any other alterations Lat 5:27 land in light

Monday 6

This day Commences with light wind cloudy at 2 AM tack ship to the East East at 4 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sail and flying gills at 10 AM tack ship to the North West at 2 AM tack to the Eastward at 6 AM set all sail the latter part of this day light wind and clear this day Altham the fore sprucer at 6 AM furl the a Brig bearing to the North West Altham implorid in ship Duty

August

Tuesday 7

This day Commences with moderate breezes and clear at 2 AM tack ship to the Eastward at 6 AM tack ship to North West at the same time furl the fore top gallant sail and flying gills at 6 AM set all sail. Light wind and clear this day Repair the Main top sail Lat 5:42 land in light

August

Wednesday 8

This day Commences with light wind and clear all sail set at 4 AM furl black fish at 6 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sail tack ship to the Eastward at 10 AM furl the Main top gallant sail at 2 AM tack ship to the North West at 6 AM set all sail at 10 AM furl a sail bearing to North West Altham implorid in repairing sails Lat 6:06 land in light

August

Thursday 9

This day Commences with brisk wind and cloudy at 4 AM tack ship to the North East at 6 AM furl the fore and Mizentop gallant sail and flying gills single reef the Main top gallant sail furl the Main sail at 8 AM tack ship the North West at 6 AM set all sail brisk breeze and cloudy Altham implorid in repairing sails Lat 6:26 Long 82:40

August

Friday 10

This 24 hours Commences with light breeze and cloudy all sail set this day found one of our Mizentop Mast spruce parted at 2 PM saw a large whale giving birth to the North West at 3 PM tack ship to the East Eastward at 4 AM tack ship to North West at 6 AM tack ship to Eastward at the same time furl the Main sail and fore top gallant sail and flying gills at 8 AM tack ship to North West later part light wind and clear Altham implorid in ship Duty Lat 6:30 Long 82:40
