August ^{Saturday 11}
This Day Commences with Light wind and Cloudy at 2 P.M. tack ship to the Eastward at 4 P.M. haul fish Struck 2 and let them. at 6 P.M. haul the fore top gallant sail and flying gill tack ship to the Southward at 4 P.M. at 6 P.M. get all sail set. All hands employed in preparing sails this was rather one of the times without wind. Lat 42:38 Long 82:10

August ^{Sunday 12}
This Day Commences with Light Wind and Cloudy at 6 P.M. tack ship to South West all sail set. at 8 P.M. haul the Main top gallant sail at and the flying gill. all the later part Light wind and Cloudy at 6 P.M. get the fore top sails haul South West all this Day haul in back. Lat 42:04 Long 82:40

August ^{Monday 13}
This Day Commences with Strong wind at 5 P.M. haul Black fish Struck 2 Caught nothing at 6 P.M. haul the fore and Mizzen top gallant sail and flying gill at 11 P.M. haul the Main top gallant sail. at 2 P.M. tack ship to the Eastward at 4 P.M. get all sail set. haul in back and Cloudy. this Day got the Mizzen top mast grooves and clear out the fore hole Lat 42:35 Long 82:30

August ^{Tuesday 14}
This Day Commences with Strong wind and Cloudy at 5 P.M. haul the fore top gallant sail and flying gill and fingle the top sail fore and aft at 6 P.M. get all sail this Day put up the Mizzen top Mast grooves. Later part Light wind and Cloudy. haul in back. All hands employed in ship's Duty Lat 42:00 Long 82:20

August ^{Wednesday 15}
This Day Commences with Light wind and Cloudy at 6 P.M. haul the fore and Mizzen top gallant sail and flying gill. at 2 P.M. tack ship to South West at 4 P.M. get all sail at 10 P.M. haul the lower Mizzen top Mast grooves. Later part Light wind and Cloudy. haul in back. All hands employed in ship's Duty Lat 42:17 Long 82:10

August ^{Thursday 16}
This Day Commences with Light wind and Cloudy at 6 P.M. haul the fore and Mizzen top gallant sails and flying gill at 10 P.M. tack ship to South East at 2 P.M. get all sail the later part of this Day calm and foggy and Rainy haul Black fish all hands employed in ship's Duty Lat 42:35 Long 82:15

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August ^{Friday 17}
This Day Commences with Light wind and Rainy at 2 P.M. tack ship to the South West all sail set at 4 P.M. tack ship to South all sail set the later part of this Day calm and foggy Light wind and fog at 4 P.M. haul the fore top gallant sail and flying gill at 6 P.M. haul the Mizzen top gallant sail and flying gill Middle part Strong wind and fog at 6 P.M. get all sail at 7 P.M. haul 10 large Whales and haul in back. Later part Strong wind and Rainy Lat 42:15 Long 82:25

August ^{Saturday 18}
This Day Commences with Light wind and foggy all sail set at 2 P.M. haul 2 large Whales Struck one caught nothing at 4 P.M. tack ship to the Eastward haul the fore and Mizzen top gallant sail and flying gill Middle part Strong wind and fog at 6 P.M. get all sail at 7 P.M. haul 10 large Whales and haul in back. Later part Strong wind and Rainy Lat 42:15 Long 82:25

August ^{Sunday 19}
This Day Commences with Strong wind and rising foggy at 5 P.M. tack the Whale a long time and took in sail for the night at 8 P.M. haul all hands and commenced for cutting the Whale later part of this Day thick and foggy. All hands employed in cutting the Whale. Lat 42:00 Long 82:30 60°

August ^{Monday 20}
This Day Commences with Strong Wind and foggy at 3 P.M. haul a long time for the night at 6 P.M. finished cutting the Whale haul the fore top gallant sail and get the fore top sail to South West at 10 P.M. commenced hauling the Whale later of this Day light wind and foggy. All hands employed in hauling Lat 42:14 Long 82:10

August ^{Tuesday 21}
This Day Commences with Light wind and heavy fog at 1 P.M. haul ship to the Eastward haul the fore top gallant sail. at 4 P.M. get the gill Mizzen top gallant sail. All hands employed in hauling Lat 42:30 Long 82:10

August ^{Wednesday 22}
This Day Commences with Strong wind at 6 P.M. haul the Mizzen top gallant sail at 8 P.M. finished hauling. at 9 P.M. haul ship to South West at 2 P.M. haul ship to the Eastward at 6 P.M. get the fore top gallant sail at the same time haul a sail to the North West hauling to the Eastward Lat 42:17 Long 82:10
