

Ship Phoebe Ann New Bedford 1827
August Thursday 23

This Day Commences with moderate wind and cloudy at 6 AM furl the top gallant sails and single reef the top sails at 7 AM wear ship to south West. at 2 PM took ship to the East after latter part light wind and clear at 6 PM gave a brigg steering to the Eastward All hand implorid in hauling down the sail. Lat 7:22 Long 82:00

August Friday 24

This Day Commences with light wind and clear at 7 AM wear ship to south West. at 9 AM set single reef top sail and top gallant sails. all hands implorid in hauling down the sail. Lat 7:21 Long 82:00

August Saturday 25

This Day Commences with light wind at 1 PM gave a brigg steering south West at the same time gave 2 large Whales and caught 2. Lat 7:20 Long 82:00 at 5 PM commenced cutting lat part of this day light wind and fog Lat 7:18 Long 82:10

August Sunday 26

This Day Commences with light wind clear. This Day finished cutting and commenced boiling. Lat part light wind and moon. Last gave murex finery back. Lat part this Day light wind and clear All hand implorid in taking care the whale. Lat 7:10 Long 82:20

August Monday 27

This Day Commences with light wind at 3 PM set the top sails and stand to for the West. Middle part of this Day light wind and clear at 12 PM wear ship to the East. All hand implorid in boiling. Lat 7:19 Long 82:40

August Tuesday 28

This Day Commences with light wind and clear at 6 AM wear ship to south at 7 finish boiling latter part light wind and thick weather. Lat 7:10 Long 82:20

August Wednesday 29

This Day Commences with light wind and fog at 7 AM wear ship to North East latter part the same at 2 PM wear ship to south West. All hand implorid in getting ready to haul the oil down. Lat 7:08 Long 81:45

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August Thursday 30

This Day Commences with light wind and thick weather at 1 PM gave a brigg of Whales but off and caught one at 3 PM took him a long fish. Lat 6:19 S. at the same time wear ship to south West at 9 PM commenced cutting at 10 PM gave a brigg steering to south West. Lat 7:19 Long 82:20

August Friday 31

The first part this Day Commences with light wind and moon. Lat 10 PM wear ship to south West at 6 PM finished cutting at 10 PM commenced boiling the latter part more wind haze. All hand implorid in boiling. Lat 7:38 Long 82:10

September Saturday 1

This Day Commences with strong wind. thick weather at 6 PM wear ship to East with double reef top sails. the latter part light wind at 10 PM wear ship to south West. All hand implorid in boiling. Lat 7:32 Long 82:10

September Sunday 2

This Day Commences with light wind at 2 PM finish boiling at the same time cutting down the oil at 6 PM wear ship to East wear double reef top sails at 2 PM wear ship to south West at 8 PM gave a shoal of Whales 14 light wind. All hand implorid in hauling down. Lat 7:30 Long 82:40

September Monday 3

This Day Commences with light wind and fine weather at 2 PM wear ship to East. single reef top sails and top gallant sails. at 6 PM furl the top gallant sails at 2 PM wear ship to south West. latter part of calm. Lat 12 at noon finish hauling down. Lat 7:48 Long 82:40

September Tuesday 4

This Day Commences with strong wind light rain at 6 PM furl flying gill Main top gallant sail single reef the top sails and wear ship to south West. latter part strong wind and clear. All hand implorid in ship duty and fitting the boats for whaling all this Day gave nothing. Lat 8:00 Long 82:10
