September Monday 17
This Day Commences with light wind and clear at 6 AM get
under the light wind sails wear ship to the south west
at 2 PM wear ship to the east ward. Latter part of the Day
light wind fair Nothing seen in company Lat 51 10 Long 81 51

September Tuesday 18
This Day Commences with light wind at 6 took
in sail and wear ship to south west. at 2 PM wear ship
to the East at 6 PM get all sail fair Nothing Lat 51 50 Long 81 51

September Wednesday 19
This Day Commences with light wind and heavy at 3 PM
fair a sail steaming to the east ward at 6 PM fair the
land at the same time wear ship to south west
the Georg. Susan in sight. Latter part light wind at 6 PM
get all sail Lat 51 35 Long 81 00

September Thursday 20
This Day Commences with light wind all sail get at 6 AM
fold the fore and main top gallant sail and flying
jib steaming to the south west the Georg. Susan in
sight at 6 AM we get all sail at 9 PM fair a sperm whale
going quick to the windward Lat 51 31 Long 81 30

September Friday 21
This Day Commences with strong wind and cloudy
at 2 PM fair 2 Whales. at 4 PM fair a sail steaming
to the east ward at double reef the top sails bend
the light sails Lat 51 51 Long 82 00

September Saturday 22
This Day Commences with strong wind at 6 AM
fold the light sail double reef the top sails the
Georg. Susan in sight. steaming south west. at 6 PM
fair Whales at 8 PM fair and struck one and threw three
board boat. Georg. Susan in sight. 8 40 Long 82 40

September Sunday 23
This Day Commences with fresh wind and rough sea over
at 2 PM fair Whales and saw one bearing track in sail for the
night steaming south west. Latter part strong wind Lat 51 34 Long 83 10

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September Monday 24
This Day Commences with strong wind at 1 AM wear ship to the
Georg. Susan in company. at 10 AM wear ship to east west at 6 PM
get the main sail and top gallant sails at 9 PM fair a large whale
going quick to the south west all hands employ'd in repairing
the foremast Lat 51 00 Long 81 40

September Tuesday 25
This Day Commences with strong wind and heavy sea
morning at night took in sail steaming to the south west at
12 at night wear ship to the East. at 6 PM fair a
sperm whale board caught nothing Latter part strong wind
fair finbacks Lat 51 00 Long 81 20 Georg. Susan in sight

September Wednesday 26
This Day Commences with strong wind and raining at
11 AM double reef the top sail fold the main sail wear
ship to south west. at 10 PM lay the main and fore back
at 6 PM fair the West. Latter part of this Day strong wind and
all hands employ'd in ship duty Lat 51 16 Long 81 51

September Thursday 27
This Day Commences with strong wind and raining at 6 PM
double reef the top sails lay a back headed to south
west. the Georg. Susan in company. this Day a finback
at 11 AM fair the West. strong wind. Lat 51 18 Long 81 50

September Friday 28
This Day Commences with strong wind under the fore
fore top sail and repaired it and bent it a gear. at 10 AM
double reef the top sails lay the main and back headed
to south west. at 6 PM fair to the north east fair hump back.
Latter part strong wind and raining Lat 51 10 Long 81 50

September Saturday 29
This Day Commences with strong wind at 2 PM wear ship to
West. at night double reef the top sails lay the main and
a back head to the south west. the Georg. Susan in sight
at 6 PM wear ship to the east ward More moderate get the
top gallant sails. fair finbacks Lat 51 45 Long 81 50
