September Sunday 30

This Day Commences with strong winds at 6 AM furled the top gallant sails. Steered to the Eastward at 6 AM Steered North East. Saw five Backs Black fish George & Jersan in Company Lat 7-28 Long 81-20

October Monday 1
This Day Commences with light wind get all sails Steered to the Westward at 4 AM gave a Boie Steaming to the Eastward at 6 AM furled the light sails for the night. at 6 AM got the Main top gallant sails Saw five Backs Black fish. Lat 7-22 Long 81-20

October Tuesday 2
This Day Commences with strong wind at 12 at Noon took ship to South West. This Day got 5 cask of Water out the George & Jersan. at 6 AM furled the Main top gallant sail. at 10 AM wore ship to the East & East. at 6 AM get all sail to part more Moderate Saw five Backs this evening the Main sail and tent. Lat 7-20 Long 81-40

October Wednesday 3
This Day Commences with Moderate wind all sails at 6 AM furled the light sail and jingle reef the top sail took ship to South West. the George & Jersan in sight. at 6 AM light wind get all sail and wore ship to South West Lat 7-03 Long 81-20

October Thursday 4
This Day Commences with light wind all sail get Steaming South West at 2 AM gave a Boie of Water to the George & Jersan and caught ~~two~~ ^{two} ~~two~~ ^{two} George & Jersan in sight. at 6 AM cut him in. Steered to the Eastward half the night at 5 AM commencing Boiling Lat 6-51 Long 80-45

October Friday 5
This Day Commences with light wind all sail get at 2 AM wore ship to South West at the same time finished Boiling but part light wind all sail get Lat 6-50 Long 80-20

This Day Commences with light wind all sail get Steaming to the Eastward the George & Jersan in Company at 6 AM furled the light sails at 6 AM got all sail at 8 AM gave a Boie of Whales at 9 AM had caught Nothing Latter part light wind Pleasant Lat 6-05 Long 81-16

October Sunday 7
This Day Commences with light wind all sail get Steaming to the East & East at 4 AM furled the light sail at 6 AM furled the Main sail at 6-10 AM took ship to South West at 2 AM wore ship to the Eastward. George & Jersan in Company at 6 AM get all sail Steered to East light wind and Pleasant gave the same Lat 6-05

October Monday 8
This Day Commences with light wind and Pleasant at 1 AM gave a Boie of Whales had caught two. at 5 AM took them a long piece and commencing cutting at 8 AM took ship to South West with 3 top sails get George & Jersan in Company at 8 AM finished cutting at 9 AM commencing Boiling and Steered to the Eastward Lat 6-05 Long 80-10

October Tuesday 9
This Day Commences with Moderate wind and heavy sea running at 8 AM gave 2 Whales going to the wind quick at 6 AM wore ship to South West jingle reef the top sails all hand employ'd in Boiling the George & Jersan in Company. at 1 AM wore ship to East & East light wind at 5 AM wore ship to South West. got the Main and fore top gallant sails. at 11 AM gave a Boie of Whales at 12 AM soon finished Boiling but 6-4 sun in sight

October Wednesday 10
This Day Commences with light wind and heavy sea running. at 6 AM furled the top gallant sails at 12 at light wore ship to East & East. at 6 AM got the fore and Main top gallant sails light wind and fog at 10 AM gave a long whale at 11 AM had and struck get him spouting blue and lost 11 hira Lat 6-06 Long 80-10
