October Thursday 11

This day commences with light wind foggy at 6 AM
wound ship to south West hauled the top gallant sails
jinglecraft the top fore top gallant sail at 2 PM
wound ship to the East ward Georg & Susan in
company at 6 PM wound ship to south West at the
same time commenced pouring down rain last part of
this day light wind lat 6-05 long 18-20

October Friday 12
This day commences with strong wind at 2 AM
wound ship to the East ward at 6 PM wound ship
to south West lay the Main yard to the Mast at the
same time hauled the Main top gallant sail at 10 AM
from the Whale that the vessel
on Wednesday took him from side lat 5-00 long 18-20

October Saturday 13
This day commences with strong wind at 2 AM com-
menced hailing at 6 PM finished hailing commenced hoisting
the Main top Double reefed the top sails the latter part
light wind. got the top gallant sail. lat 5-49 long 18-40

October Sunday 14
This day commences with light wind all hand employed
in hoisting. Georg & Susan in company at 12 o'clock
took ship to the Eastward at 2 PM finished hoisting at 4 PM
gave 2 sails hoisting south West last part light wind
at 10 AM gave back the sails lat 5-39 long 18-40

October Monday 15
This day commences with light wind at 6 AM
wound ship to south West. at 6 PM hauled the top gallant
sails. Georg & Susan in company. at 6 PM took ship to south
West at the same time got the Main top gallant sail lat 5-25 long 18-40

October Tuesday 16
The first part of this day commences with strong wind at 8 AM
wound ship to south West this day employed in cooping the
Mast. at Night gave a ship steaming south West Georg & Susan
in company. at 10 PM gave a ship lat 5-35 long 18-20

October Wednesday 17

This day commences with light wind at 6 AM gave the ship
Maria of New Bedford 25th North out 1400. Board at 12 at Night
took ship to south West all hand employed in hoisting
at 10 AM finished hoisting down at 11 AM wound ship to the Eastward. latter
part of this day commences with strong wind lat 5-29 long 18-40

October Thursday 18
The first part of this day strong wind all sail got the Maria in company
at 9 AM took ship to south West and hauled the
light sails Double reefed the top sails. at 4 PM wound ship to Eastward
at 6 PM cast one reef out the Main top sail. got the Main top
gallant sail. latter part light wind lat 5-28 long 18-40

October Friday 19
The first part of this day commences with light wind
Middle part strong wind hauled the Main top gallant sail at
at 6 AM got the Main sail and Main top gallant sail at 11 AM
gave a large quantity of fresh water lat 5-40 long 18-40

October Saturday 20
This day commences with fresh breezes gave a great quantity
of fresh water at 6 PM hauled the Main top gallant sail took ship
to Eastward. at 6 PM took ship to south West at the same time
got all sail all hand employed in cleaning ship latter part
light wind

October Sunday 21
The first part of this day light wind all sail got at 1 PM
wound ship to Eastward at 6 PM hauled the light sails
this day gave a large quantity of fresh water at 10 AM wound
ship to south West. at 6 PM got all sail latter part light wind
lat 5-20 long 18-40

October Monday 22
This day commences with light wind all sail got at 1
PM gave a large number of hump back at 2 PM spoke the ship
Maria of New Bedford 25th North out 1450. they gave Whales
and caught 2 at 4 PM hauled the light sails. Hoisting 6th East.
at 6 PM got all sail wound ship to south West light wind and pleasant
at 10 PM Board the ship Maria and got a Boston Breeze
for a better gave a great number of hump back and
fin back lat 5-47 long 18-40
