January 8
This day commenced with light wind and pleasant from five back at 4 P.M. finish of the wind down at to the point. Hearing 6 P.M. back at 6 P.M. get all sail all hand employed in repairing sails light wind and pleasant weather at 10 P.M. get an observation the Longi. Observation 110° 9' Longi for 109° 20' Lat. 35° 30'

January 9 Wednesday
This day commences with strong wind and pleasant at 6 P.M. furl the light sail. Hearing North East at 6 P.M. get all sail Moderate wind and pleasant all hand employed in ship duty Lat 2° 53' Longi 109° 45'

January 10 Thursday
This day commences with Moderate wind at night took in sail hearing North East at 6 P.M. get all sail two batterpart Moderate wind and Rainy. Saw black fish all hand employed in ship duty Lat 1° 59' Longi 110° 05'

January 11 Friday
This day commences with light wind all sail set at 6 P.M. furl the light sails. Hearing to North by East at 6 P.M. get all sail batterpart light Rain saw porpoises all hands employed in ship duty Lat 1° 20' Longi 110° 25'

January 12 Saturday
This day commences with light wind and pleasant at 6 P.M. furl the light sails. Hearing North by East at 6 P.M. get all sail at the same time saw a ship hearing south at 10 P.M. saw a sperm whale. All hand employed in ship duty Lat 1° 25' Longi 110° 35'

January 13 Sunday
This day commences with light wind all sail set a ship in sight cutting at 4 P.M. saw large whale. Saw and caught nothing saw the Congress of Nantucket 14 Months out 12 P.M. Bks. at 6 P.M. furl the light sails. Hearing south at 12 at night took ship to North East at 6 P.M. get all sail saw nothing the batterpart of this day Lat 94 Miles from Longi 110° 40'

January 14 Monday
This day commences with light wind all sail set at 2 P.M. took ship to south at 4 P.M. spoke the Congress of Nantucket 14 Months out at the same time took ship to the North East at 6 P.M. furl the

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Light sails at 6 P.M. get all sail. took ship to south the wind light and pleasant saw porpoises at 10 P.M. took ship to the North East all hand employed in ship duty Lat 43° 00' Longi 110° 10'

January 15 Tuesday
This day commences with light wind all sail set at dawn took ship to the south at 4 P.M. saw a ship hearing to the North East at 6 P.M. furl the light sails at 2 P.M. took ship to the North East at 6 P.M. get all sail at 8 P.M. took ship to south West at 10 P.M. took ship to the North light wind and pleasant saw porpoises all hand employed in fitting the fore rigging Lat 42° 00' Longi 110° 20'

January 16 Wednesday
This day commences with light and pleasant hearing south at 6 P.M. get all sail furl the fore and Mizzen top galvant sails and flying gib at 6 P.M. get all sail clear pleasant weather at 10 P.M. took ship to the North East saw two porpoises all hands employed in ship duty Lat 1° 00' South Longi 111° 10'

January 17 Thursday
This day commences with light wind and pleasant all sail set hearing to the North East at 6 P.M. furl the light sails at 6 P.M. Calm at 8 P.M. light wind and Rain this day commences fitting of the fore rigging all hand employed. Saw black fish batterpart fresh wind Lat 1° 15' Longi 111° 45'

January 18 Friday
This day commences with fresh wind at 4 P.M. furl the fore top sail at night hearing south at 6 P.M. get all sail light wind and pleasant at 10 P.M. saw a ship hearing to the south all hand employed in ship duty

January 19 Saturday
This day commences with light wind and pleasant all sail set hearing south at 6 P.M. furl the light sails at 6 P.M. get the light sail all hand employed in ship duty this day on the line batterpart of the day fine weather Longi 113° 35' Lat 12° 12'

January 20 Sunday
This day commences with light wind all sail set hearing to the North at 6 P.M. furl the light sails at 6 P.M. get the light sail took ship at the same time at 8 P.M. saw a Dead Whale
