got all sail steaming south West light wind and pleasant all
hand employed in ships duty lat 8-12 south Longi 132-55

February Thursday 28

This day commences with light wind and pleasant all sail
put steaming south West at 6 AM put the Main sail Main
top gallant sail. Lay the Main gear to the Mast. Heeded
to south. this middle part strong wind at 8 AM kept sail
at 10 AM got all sail all hand employed in ships duty lat 9-01 Longi 133-20

February Friday 29

This day commences with fresh wind all sail put at noon kept
West at 6 AM put the light sail Double Reef the top sail lay
Main top sail to the Mast. Heeded to North East at 10 AM moved
ships to south at 12 at night moved ship to North East at 4 AM spoke
a ship from London 11 Months out 3-50 Sails. at the same time
kept West at 8 AM got all sail lat 9-12 Longi 135-20

2 March Saturday 1

This day commences with fresh wind Steaming West by
south all sail put at 6 AM put the fore and Main
top gallant sails. at 8 AM put all sail Steaming by south the
ships in sight all hand employed in ships duty lat 9-37 Longi 137-30

3 March Sunday 2

This day commences with light wind and pleasant the ship
in sight at 6 AM put the fore and Main top gallant sail
steaming West by south the Middle part light wind and
pleasant at 3 AM light squalls of Rain at 9-51 Longi 138-30

4 March Monday 3

This day commences with light wind and pleasant all sail put
at 6 AM put the light sail Double Reef the top sails lay the
ship to this wind Heeded the North East the Middle part light
wind at 4 AM kept off by south still sail lat 9-52 Longi 139-00

5 March Tuesday 4

This day commences with strong wind Steaming by south
at 6 AM lay the ship to the wind Heeded East Double Reef
the top sails put the top gallant sail hauled the fore sail
up at 8 AM at 10 AM kept the ship West by south got all sail

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at 10 AM saw the Marquesas Island bearing Circumpar 1/2 South
distance about 40 miles the lat of the Island 9-00 Longi 139-30 West

March Wednesday 6

This day commences with light wind and pleasant 4 Sails in sight
at 4 AM put the top sails all sail put at 8 AM kept West all this
light wind and pleasant all hand idle lat 10-00 Longi 139-39

7 March Thursday 6

This day commences with light winds of rain all sail set after
noon by south the land at 4 AM bearing Circumpar North East about
12 leagues from which I take my departure for the Society Islands
the last and longitude of these Islands are lat 9-55 south Longi
139-09 West this is the last and Longi of Ootahoo or Resolution Bay
from which I take my departure at 6 AM put the fore top
Main top sailing sail. Steaming West by south the Watch
employed in tanning lat 10-55 Longi New obs. 140-45

8 March Friday 7

This day commences with fresh wind and light rain all sail
put steaming West at 4 AM kept the ~~Cham~~ Cham but the
Anchark on the bow at 6 AM took in the Steaming sail top gallant
and sail Main sail fore sail the Middle part light wind and
pleasant at 8 AM got all sail latter part light rain the Watch
employed in tanning lat 10-37 Longi 141-37 Obs

9 March Saturday 8

This day commences with light wind and pleasant Steaming
to the Westward at 6 AM took in the Steaming sail top gallant
sail fore and Main sail at 9 AM kept the land Heeded to
the North East at 12 at night moved ship to south the latter part
light wind and squally at 6 AM got all sail Steamed to the south
this day Craped the ship out fire lat 11-05 Longi 142-50 Obs

10 March Sunday 9

This day commences with light wind and squally at night
put the light sails took in the fore and Main sail
steaming 2 South West this evening saw some sharp
lightning in the East the Middle part squally with rain
latter part calm lat 11-37 Longi 143-27 Obs
