March Monday 10
This day commences with a calm the shells part light squalls with Rain latter part Moderate wind at Day Light set all sail steaming West this day got the Patch. half Watches. they Watch imploded in Ship's Duty Last 11:26 Longi 144:57

March Tuesday 11
This day commences with light wind and pleasant all sail at the Wind from E. East. Steaming West by South at 6 P.M. took in the fore top Mast Steaming sail. at 10 P.M. furl'd the top gallant and light wind and squally attended with Rain. thunder and lightning. the latter part light wind and variable Steaming West by South this day observation Lat. 11:30 Longi 145:43

March Wednesday 12
This day commences with light wind and variable from South to North East all sail set Steaming West by South at 6 P.M. took in the fore top Mast Steaming sail fore and Main top gallant sails at 8 P.M. lay the ship to the Wind Heaved to the South East at 10 P.M. Heavy squalls from the East attended with wind Rain thunder and lightning the latter part strong wind Double brist the top sail at 11 P.M. East on the top set Main top * gallant sail fore top Mast Steaming sail. Lat. 11:41 Longi 146:48

March Thursday 13
This day commences with light wind attended with Rain the wind variable. boars Wh. South. gave from Birds. and fish. at 6 P.M. furl'd the light sails left to the wind Heaved to the South at 12 at Night tack ship to the South light wind pleasant at Daylight Capt of Wh. South. set all sail. the latter part fresh Wind from E. East Lat 11:58 Longi 147:45

March Friday 14
This day commences with Moderate wind all sail set Boars West by South. the wind E. South East. at 6 P.M. furl'd the light sails. halloed the fore jibs the Middle part squally at 12 at Night wore ship to South South East at 3 P.M. brist the top sails up strong squalls attended with Rain. at Daylight Capt of the Boars West South West. set all sail the watch imploded in Ship's Duty Last 12:26 Longi 148:35

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March Saturday 15
This day commences with strong wind all sail set Steaming West South West. at 2 P.M. furl'd the light sail. the weather squally. Cleat brist the top sails at 6 P.M. heaved the fore sail up left the ship to the North. at 11 P.M. furl'd the fore and Main top sail strong wind attended Rain. thunder and lightning. at Day Light Capt of South South West. we set the top sails jingle brist the fore top Mast Steaming sail Main sail Main top gallant sail. the wind more Moderate. from E. South East. at 12 at Night wore ship to the South. Last 12:55 Longi 149:18

March Sunday 16
This day commences with fresh wind all sails set Steaming South South West. at 3 P.M. a strong squall from E. S. E. at 6 P.M. brist the ship to South by East Cleat the brist the top sails furl'd the gill and Main sail, at 10 P.M. brist the to North East at 1 P.M. wore ship to South at Day Light set all sail. the wind more Moderate. all this Night sharp lightning Lat 13:54 Longi 149:25

March Monday 17
This day commences with light wind and pleasant at 8 P.M. a squall from East took in the light sails Double brist the top sails Steaming South. this day the wind variable. gave a number of Birds at 9 P.M. furl'd the Main sail. at 10 P.M. wore ship to the North East at 12 at Night Heavy wind and Rain lightning at the same time wore ship to South at Day Light set all sail at 4 P.M. strong squalls of wind and Rain. latter part Moderate wind and pleasant all sail set. Last 14:36 Longi 149:15

March Tuesday 18
This day commences with pleasant at 2 P.M. strong squalls of wind and Rain. at Night furl'd the top gallant sail. Main sail Steaming South South East. the Wind E. East. at 11 P.M. wore ship to North at 1 P.M. wore ship to South at Day Light set all sail. light wind and pleasant at 10 P.M. gave the Land. the sound of Society I heard. at noon boars gave the South West Dist a boar 15 Leagues. Lat. 15:48 Longi 149:30

March Wednesday 19
This day commences with light wind and pleasant
