April Sunday 6
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant. the Middle part light squalls of Rain lat part light wind and Pleasant sent the Main top gallant yards up all hand in pairs in getting ships for sea

April Monday 7
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant, the wind from North ^{South} one for water, the Middle part hazy & latter part light wind and Pleasant all hands for sea the first

April Tuesday 8
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant the latter part the same at 8 AM set to sea light wind from East all hands in place in clearing up ships Lat 46:10 Longi 151:49

April Wednesday 9
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant all sail set bearing to the North West the Middle part fresh wind took the light sail latter part Moderate wind Lat 45:23 Longi 151:40

April Thursday 10
This day commences with strong wind at 8 PM Double kept the top sails under the Main sail and gill at 10 PM set the gill bearing ESE the wind from North at 11 PM set the Main sail. Lat one kept out the top sails. set the Main top gallant sail latter part light wind and variable took ships to the best advantage. the Watch implored in repairing sails. Lat 45:02 Longi 151:15

April Friday 11
This day commences with light wind and squally with Rain all sail set to the best advantage. bearing North. the wind variable the Middle part light air from North East. the latter part the same the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 44:12 Longi 151:35

April Saturday 12
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant bearing North West by North the wind from North East. the Middle part all sail set the wind E South East bearing N E East the latter part wind from North East the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 43:32 Longi 152:00

April Sunday 13
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant all sail set

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to the best advantage bearing North by West. the wind from N West. the Middle part light wind and Pleasant at 6 AM set the yards set the fore top Mast bearing fair from East Lat 42:00 Longi 152:10

April Monday 14
This day commences with light wind from E East all sail at 4 PM gave Blunt Stand Lat 41:28 South Longi 152:06 West at 10 PM set the flying jib fore top Mast bearing fair. bearing North by West. the Middle part light wind and Pleasant. the latter the same the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 40:26 Longi 152:26

April Tuesday 15
This day commences with light wind and Pleasant all sail set bearing North by West. the wind from East at 12 PM gave an Stand that is not on the Chart nor in the Navigator. this land bearing North & West from Point Stand Dist 87 Miles. at 4 PM set the light sails Double kept the top sail under the Canvas up Lat 39:00 East. the Middle part light squalls of Rain at 4 PM set all sail kept of N West latter part strong wind and Pleasant the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 38:00 Longi 152:30

April Wednesday 16
This day commences with strong wind from E East all sail set bearing North by West at 6 PM set the light sails and Main sail and gill Double kept the top sail and kept to the wind the Middle part strong squalls of Rain attended with Rain the latter part light wind and Pleasant all sail set the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 37:44 Longi 153:00 West

April Thursday 17
This day commences with strong squalls under the top gallant sails Double kept the top sails. bearing by the wind. the wind from North East at 9 PM hallooed the Main sail up. the Middle part more Moderate. with light wind. the latter part attended with squalls of Rain light wind from E East the Watch implored in ships duty Lat 37:11 Longi 153:40 West

April Friday 18
This day commences with light wind from East all sail set bearing North at 8 PM under the flying jib fore top gallant sail the Middle part light wind and Pleasant. the at 10 PM commenced Rain at 10 PM gave a photo of Whaler and lowered caught 2 Lat 36:28 Longi 153:46
