Sunday 11

This day Commences with light wind from South East. all sail set
Heaving West by South. at 4 light from the Main sail. at 2 o'clock
took in the fore top Mast Heaving sail at 8 o'clock. got the Heaving
sail. light Wind and Pleasant at 10 o'clock. Lat 19-20 North Long 165-30

May

Monday 12

This day Commences with light wind from East by South and Pleasant
Heaving West by South. all sail set at 2 o'clock from Black fish house
at 4 o'clock. got the fore top Mast Heaving sail. light wind and Pleasant
at 10 o'clock. Lat 19-20 North Long 164-40 West.

May

Tuesday 13

This day Commences with light wind from East. and Pleasant
all sail set Heaving West. at 4 o'clock. changed to North East at
6 o'clock. got the fore top gallant sail. at the same time altered the
Coast to West by South at 8 o'clock. light squalls of rain latter part of the day
fresh Wind from East the Watch imployed in repairing sails and backing
on a cum Lat 19-03 North. Long 166-20 West.

May

Wednesday 14

This day Commences with strong wind from East and Pleasant all
sail set Heaving West by South. at 1 o'clock. changed the Coast to West South West
for wind and Pleasant all sail set. the Watch imployed in repairing
the sails and painting the boat Lat 18-46 North Long 167-36

May

Thursday 15

This day Commences with fresh wind from East and Pleasant all sail
set. Heaving West by South at 4 o'clock. changed the Main top sail.
the middle part fresh wind and Pleasant Lat 18-40 North. the Watch imployed
in repairing sails and painting the boat.

May

Friday 16

Lat 18-52 Long 170-33

This day Commences with fresh Breeze from East and Pleasant
all sail set Heaving West by South & South. at 6 o'clock. got the fore
top Mast Heaving sail. at 6 o'clock. got it again strong wind and Pleasant
this day Repair the Main sail and bent it again Lat. Long 170-30

May

Saturday 17

This day Commences with strong wind from East and Pleasant
Heaving West by South & South at 4 o'clock. took in the Heaving sail

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at 8 o'clock. got the Main top gallant sail at 3 o'clock. got them again
Heaving West by South. strong wind and Pleasant the
Watch imployed in ship duty Lat 18-50 North Long 173-30. accou
May Sunday 18

Lat 18-28

This day Commences with strong wind from East. Heaving
West by South. all sail set. at 6 o'clock. got the Heaving sail and the
Main top gallant sail. Double reefed the top sails. the Watch
lost strong wind and Pleasant. at 8 o'clock. light squalls of rain. at 10
o'clock. got all sail set Lat 18-46 North Long 173-20 West

May

Monday 19

This day Commences with strong wind from East. Heaving
West by South. all sail set at 3 o'clock. Heaving West at 6 o'clock. Coast kept the top sail
lost by the wind to the North. strong wind and Pleasant. at 10
o'clock. got the fore top gallant sail. at 2 o'clock. got the top sail to North at 2 o'clock. got the top sail
a sail. got the top sail and kept the top sail. kept the top sail. the
Watch imployed in ship duty Lat 19-44 North Long 179-94 West

May

Tuesday 20

This day Commences with strong wind from East. Heaving
West by South. Double reef top sails and Main sail at 6 o'clock
took in sail for the night. left to the wind. at 10 o'clock. got the top sail
East at 2 o'clock. got the top sail to North at 5 o'clock. kept the top sail
fine wind and Pleasant all hand imployed in repairing sails

May

Wednesday 21 Lat 20-46 North Long 179-50 East

This day Commences with light wind from East all sail set Heaving
West by South at 6 o'clock. took in sail for the night at 10 o'clock. got the top sail
to South East. at 2 o'clock. got the top sail to North. at 5 o'clock. got all sail light
wind and Pleasant Heaving North West by North the Watch imployed
in ship duty Lat 21-48 North Long 179-20 East

May

Thursday 22

This day Commences with light wind and Pleasant all sail set
Heaving West by South. at 6 o'clock. took in sail for the night and left
to the wind at 10 o'clock. got the top sail & South East at 6 o'clock. got the top sail
ship to North. to the point call this day Repair the fore sail
and bent it again the Watch imployed in ship duty Lat 21-51 North Long 178-30 East

May

Friday 23

This day Commences with a calm at 4 o'clock. light squalls
