

Ship *Phoebe Ann* New Bedford 1826
June Tuesday 3

This Day Commences with light wind from East & East and clearing
steering North West at 4 P.M. Hoisted the ship's Taper of Masts
29 Masts with 2180 Barrels. bound to the Sandwich Islands
with the help of Boats. at night lay to the north. Latter part light
wind and fog. Low Pinbacks Lat 30-10 North Longi 175-50 East

June Wednesday 4 461

This Day Commences with light wind from South West at 2 P.M.
saw a school of Whales going West by South put all sail in
Clare at 3 P.M. hove and caught nothing at 4 P.M. put the fore and
Mizen top sail. Heaved to South West. the wind from South
South East. at 5 P.M. put all sail steering N.W. West. at 6 P.M. saw a
large sperm Whale. hove and struck him. him 2 miles and
iron broke the other and came on board at 10 P.M. found a
school of Whales. struck one killed him. at 12 P.M. took him
along side Lat Longi 175-25 East.

June Thursday 5

This Day Commences with light wind all hand imployed
cutting at 5 P.M. finished cutting. put the fore and
Mizen top sails. Clearest kept the ship's sails. Heaved to
the East and the wind at 7 P.M. East. and fog. at 4 P.M. veered
ships to N.W. West. the wind at South at 6 P.M. put the top sails and
Main top gallant sail. at 10 P.M. hove and the boat picked up timber
all hand imployed in boiling. Lat Longi 176-40 East

June Friday 6

This Day Commences with light wind and fog the wind from
South. steering N.W. West. at 6 P.M. put the top sails. at 5 P.M. put
the top sails. Main top gallant sails all hand imployed in boiling
the wind from North and clear. Lat 30-18 North Longi 175-45 East

June Saturday 7

This Day Commences with light wind from North East and
pleasant. finish boiling. take in sail for the night. steering
South West by South. the Middle part Calm at 5 P.M. put the top sail
Main top gallant sail. the latter part light wind from East
steering South West by South. Lat 30-51 North Longi 176-10 East.

June Sunday 8

Ship *Phoebe Ann* New Bedford 1826.

This Day Commences with light wind from East. all sail put steering
N.W. West. at 6 P.M. Double. kept the top sails. put the gills. the Middle
part Calm. Latter part light wind from East. J. East at 10 P.M. East out
one reef out the top sail put the Main top gallant sail. all.
Hand imployed in hanning down oil Lat 30-29 Longi 175-25 East

June Monday 9

This Day Commences with light wind from E. J. East. steering
N.W. West at 6 P.M. Clearest kept the top sails. at Day Light put all sail
Moderate wind from East and foggy. Lat 29-26 North Longi 175-05 East

June Tuesday 10

This Day Commences with Moderate wind from North East. at 4 P.M.
Kept of South West. at 6 P.M. shifted the fore top sail. at 4 P.M. put the
fore and Mizen top sail. Clearest kept the Main top sail. Left to the
Wind North by West. at Day Light put all sail Kept off N.W. at 4 P.M.
Whales hove and struck one and lost him. Lat 29-21 North Longi 174-50 East

June Wednesday 11 5 7549

This Day Commences with strong wind from E. J. East. all sail
put at 1 P.M. saw Whales hove and caught one at 4 P.M. took
him along side. Heaved to N. East. hove the top sail at
Day Light veered ship to South. E. by South and commenced cutting
latter part the Day light wind all hand imployed cutting Lat 29-24 East

June Thursday 12

This Day Commences with light wind from E. J. East. all hand in
in cutting. at 5 P.M. finish. put the fore sail Clearest kept Main top sail
at 9 P.M. commenced boiling Mizen part light wind and clear.
latter part strong wind all hand imployed in boiling Lat 29-14 Longi 175-10 East

June Friday 13

This Day Commences with strong wind from East steering N.W. West
under Clearest kept Main top sail and fore sail. Mizen part
Light wind at 4 P.M. veered ship to N. East. saw pin backs. all hand
in in boiling Lat 29-00 North Longi 175-15 East.

June Saturday 14

This Day Commences with light wind and pleasant the wind
at East steering N. East. at 12 at night finish boiling. at
Day Light put the top sail Double kept. this Day Regulated the
two Decks Lat 29-36 North Longi 175-45 East.
