this Day Commence showing the after hole. at 4 AM put the top
gails, saw five Backs Black fish. and Porpoises. the latter part
More wind all hand employed in Heaving Down Lat 29° 59' Long 175° 00'

Monday 16

This Day Commences with strong wind and squally. clearing
with East and West Cloud kept for Main top sail and fore sail, at
AM finished showing. saw a Dead Whale. But spilt. at 4 PM
Veard ship to south. put the fore and Main top sail at 4 PM.
put the top sail Double kept strong wind and Pleasant saw nothing
Lat 29° 26' North. Long 174° 26' East.

June

Tuesday 17

This Day Commences with strong wind from E. & East and Pleasant
Heaving 1/2 Mast. single reef top sails gill Main top gallant sail
at 4 PM. put the gill fore and Main top sail. Main top gallant
sail. left to the wind. to the south at Day. put the top sail. Main
top gallant sail at noon kept off West. Lat 28° 59' North Long 174° 00' East

June

Wednesday 18

This Day Commences with light wind from south East. and Pleasant
at 4 PM put the Main top gallant sail. Heaving West at 11 AM
night the wind from south West. at 5 PM Double reef the top sails at 11 AM
put the fore and Main top sail and gill. Lat Long 173° 40' East

June

Thursday 19

This Day Commences with strong wind from N. & West. & Heaving West
at 4 PM Veard ship to the south. put the fore sail Cloud kept the
Main top sail. at 5 PM put the fore sail and fore sail Lat 29° 28' Long
173° 20'

June

Friday 20

This Day Commences with strong wind from N. & West. at noon Veard
ship to East. at 4 PM put the fore sail. at 5 PM put the top sail
single reef at 9 PM put the top gallant sail and Main sail at 4
PM Veard ship to West wind from N. & East Lat 29° 27' Long 173° 50' East

June

Saturday 21

First part of these 24 hours of light wind from N. & East at 4 PM Veard
ship to West. at 4 PM put the light sails and top sails. 5 PM put the
top sails top gallant sails light wind and Pleasant Lat 29° 26' Long 174° 43' East
Long 175° 00' East

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First part of these 24 hours Commences with light wind from North East. all sails
put and West. at 4 PM put the top gallant sail. Double reef the top
sails. the middle part light wind from East. at 5 PM put all sail clear
North at 9 AM. saw a Dead Whale. Lat 30° 50' North Long 175° 12' East

June

Monday 22

These 24 hours Commences with light wind from East and Pleasant
sail put clearing North East. at 4 PM put the top gallant sail and gill
fore and Main top sails and Main sail Cloud kept the Main top
sail. the middle part light wind at 5 PM put all sail. clear North then with
improvement repairing the fore top sail saw Porpoises Lat 32° 04' North Long 174° 21' 06"

June

Tuesday 23

This Day Commences with light wind from south East. and Pleasant
all sail put clearing North at 2 PM. picked up a spar and left to Sea
at 4 PM. took in sail for the night. Heaved to the East East. at Day light put
all sail. at 5 PM put the fore top gallant sail single reef the top
sail. Veard ship to N. & West. fresh wind and foggy at noon Veard ship to
East. f. East. saw Porpoises Lat 32° 24' North Long 175° 05' East.

June

Wednesday 24

This Day Commences with light wind from N. & East East. with single reef
top sail. Main top gallant sail put saw Porpoises. coming from West.
saw Brachies at night Cloud kept the top sail. put the Main sail
gill. at 5 PM put all sail. light wind and Pleasant Lat 32° 14' North Long 175° 18'

June

Thursday 25

This Day Commences with light wind from N. & West all sail put clearing
south East. at 2 PM saw a large Whale. coming to North East. at 4 PM
Landed and struck and Drained the carcass. Came on board took in
sail for the night. at 5 PM put the top sail Main top gallant sail
at the same time saw a large Whale. at 4 PM Landed and struck and
killed him at 11 PM took him alongs side. Lat 31° 48' North Long 175° 25'

June

Friday 26

This Day Commences with light wind from south West. and Pleasant
unt. all hand employed in cutting at 5 PM. finished cutting the
Body. lay by the Head Heaved to. South East. at 1 PM. Commence
Boiling at 4 PM but the Head light squally Rain. Lat 31° 52' Long 175° 45' East

This Day Commence with light wind from N. & West and Pleasant
