the wind from south East and pleasant steam from south West. the watch employed in ship's duty lat 31:01 north Longi 147:40 East.

July Thursday 10

This day commences with light wind from south East all sails set steaming by the wind to J. West. saw five black porpoises. at 4 P.M. furl'd the top sail close at reef the Main top sail. the fore part of the night light breeze from South East the night more moderate at day light set all sails steam south by West. at 5 P.M. saw a ship steaming north East lat 31:24 North Longi 147:35 West.

July Friday 11

This day commences with moderate wind from south East & East. with all sails set. steaming south by West. at night furl'd the top sail at day light set all sails. Light wind from E. of East steaming J. J. W. at 10 P.M. saw a bank of a Mast. lat 30:46 North Longi 147:10

July Saturday 12

This day commences with light wind from E. of East steaming J. J. West all sails set. at night furl'd the top sail. day to the south East. Day light set the top sails. Light wind from south East. steaming J. J. West at 10 P.M. saw a ship to North. lat 30:40 Longi 146:45 E

July Sunday 13 12 56

This day commences with light wind from south East steaming north all sails set at 6 P.M. saw a school of sperm whales at 8 P.M. furl'd the fore and Mizzen top sails and the courses close at reef the Main top sail steamed to the North North West. till 12 at night then hauled to the wind to the North East. at Day light set all sails steamed to North the wind at south lat 31:46 North Longi 148:26

July Monday 14

This day commences with light wind from south all sails set steaming East. at 5 P.M. spoke the schooner of New Bedford 15 tons the crew 4:30 barrels. at night furl'd the top sail day to the East. at Day light set all sails steam East by south the wind at south at 11 P.M. saw porpoises. saw ship to the West. lat Longi 148:35 E

July Tuesday 15

This day commences with light wind from south and pleasant all sails set. steaming E. of East. at 4 P.M. spoke the ship Independence of New Bedford with 13:30 barrels 13 months out at 8 P.M. furl'd

the top sails headed to the Eastward. at Day light set all sails light wind from South East the wind from south lat 31:36 North Longi 148:52 East

July Wednesday 16

This day commences with light wind from south south West all sails set. steaming E. of East. saw porpoises. at night furl'd the top sails the middle part light wind at Day light set all sails steam North East the wind at south all hands employed in ship's duty lat 31:58 Longi 147:08

July Thursday 17

This day commences with light wind from south all sails set at night furl'd the top sails. Light wind from South East. at Day light set all sails light wind from south saw porpoises first East the watch employed in ship's duty lat 31:36 North Longi 147:17 East.

July Friday 18

This day commences with a Calm at furl'd the top sails. at Day light set the top sails latter part Calm lat 31:25 Longi 147:40 E

July 17 14 Saturday 19 13 58

The first part these 24 hours Calm at then set with Rain at 8 P.M. Light wind from E. of South East at 4 P.M. saw a school of Whales toward Vranck one lat hove in consequence of his cutting the line off. the whales were coming to South West. at night furl'd the top sails day to the night headed to the North East. at Day light set all sails steam to the North West. at 6 P.M. saw a school of Whales coming to the East south East toward caught nothing. came on board and saw ship to the East. the wind at East. lat 31:58 North Longi 148:42 East.

July 15 Sunday 12 59

First part these 24 hours commences with strong wind from East all sails set steaming by the wind to the East at tack glass to 3 P.M. at the same time furl'd the Main top gallant sail and Main sail. at 6 P.M. saw a school of Whales coming to the North West. at 7 P.M. furl'd the top sails. and furl'd the fore and Mizzen. at midnight furl'd the fore sail at Day light set all sails. saw ship to south East at 8 P.M. saw a large Whale coming to the North West. toward caught nothing lat 16 Longi 148:58

July Monday 21 60

This day commences with light wind from E. of East all sails set. in chase of Whales coming North West. toward caught
