Main top gallant sail the latter part squally attended with rain. this day put the Larkins Boat on the fore and quarter all his day ahead stood East. Lat 33:15 North Long 118:00

July Tuesday 22

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from E. by S. and squally. at 4 P.M. Veered ship to south at 5 P.M. the top sail and the courses. the middle part strong wind and squally with rain. at Day light got the top sail Cleared. Reefed at 10 A.M. More or less got jingle Reef top sail Main top gallant sail and Main sail. tack ship to E. by E. the wind at south East Lat 33:30 Long 118:15

July Wednesday 23

The first part of these 24 Hours Commences with strong wind at night hauled the top sail Lay to E. by E. the wind at south East at Day light got the top sail Double Reefed at 5 P.M. more moderate East one Reefed the top sails got the Main sail Main top gallant sail. the wind E. by East. Lat 33:40 North Long 118:15 East.

July Thursday 24

These 24 Hours Commences with squalls of wind and rain at 3 P.M. furled the Main top gallant sail Main sail Double Reefed the Main top sail the wind at E. by East. steering south this night got the watch half and half. at Day light got the Main sail the wind at south E. by East. steering south by East. the last part strong wind and pleasant Lat 32:47 Long 118:00 East

July Friday 25

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from south E. by East steering south by West. Double Reef top sails and courses. at night furled the Main sail strong wind and cloudy latter part more moderate at 11 A.M. got the Main sail Lat 32:32 North Long 118:00 East.

July Saturday 26

These 24 Hours Commences with moderate wind from E. by East Double Reef top sail courses steering south at 12 at night tack ship to North East by North the wind at E. by South at Day light last one Reef on the Main top sail got the Main top gallant sail. Lat 31:20 Long 118:00 East.

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July Sunday 27

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from E. by East with jingle Reef top sail Main top gallant sail at 4 P.M. furled the Main sail tack ship to J. by East the wind at East. furled the Main top gallant sail Double Reefed the top sail the middle part strong wind latter part more moderate got the Main sail East one Reefed the Main top sail at 4 P.M. Veered ship to East. at 10 P.M. Veered ship to J. by East. the wind at East. gave in Backs Lat 30:55 North Long 118:50

July Monday 28

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind at East at 1 P.M. tack ship to N. by East at 6 P.M. furled the Main sail Veered ship to J. by East. at the same time Double Reefed the Main top sail. the middle part strong wind. at 3 P.M. furled the gill at 5 P.M. Cleared Reefed the fore and Main top sail. unbenet the gill. repaired it. Lat 30:20 North Long 118:15 East

July Tuesday 29

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind and pleasant. under Cleared Reef top sail and fore sail steering J. by East. the wind at East at 2 P.M. bent the gill. the middle part more moderate East one Reefed the top sail got the gill. Main top gallant sail Main sail at 3 P.M. furled the Main top gallant sail. the wind at E. by East Lat 29:25 North Long 118:00 East

July Wednesday 30

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from E. by East steering south East. jingle Reef top sail and courses at 5 P.M. tack ship to North the wind at East. the watch impleid in nothing rains. at 6 P.M. gave in Backs. at 7 P.M. Veered ship to East. the wind at E. by East. at the same time Cleared Reefed the top sails the. Lat 29:55 North Long 117:55 East.

July Thursday 31

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind and squally at 2 P.M. furled the fore and Main top sail. at 6 P.M. Veered ship to North the wind at E. by East. the middle part light wind and pleasant. at Daylight got the top sail jingle Reefed Main sail gill and Main top gallant sail at fresh wind furled the Main top gallant sail. Lat Long 119:42 East. Berabunt this day got an abundance of porpoise the Long 119:42 West.
