Main sail. Strong wind and squally with rain latter part moon. Moderate set the Main top sail Lat. 32° 13' North Longi 172° 20' West.

August

Monday 25

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from East Coast Reef top sails fore sail Main sail and gills set steering from N. East to North East. the Middle part light wind from south East. at 4 PM East out two there out East top sail set the Main top gallant sail. the watch imployed in repairing sails Lat 32° 13' North Longi 172° 15' West.

August

Tuesday 26

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and squally with light rain. at 8 AM hauled the Main top gallant sail. Double Reef the fore top sail. the wind Variable. at 8 PM hauled the Main sail latter part moon moderate set the Main sail East out one Reef out the top sail set the Main top gallant sail at 8 PM took ship to south East. the wind at 8 PM East the watch imployed in repairing sails. Lat 33° 10' Longi 172° 14' West.

August

Wednesday 27

These 24 Hours Commences with moderate wind from E. East and pleasant all sail set. steering E. of East. Middle part strong wind and pleasant. latter part squally at 9 PM hauled the Main top gallant sail the watch imployed in repairing sails Lat 32° 12' North Longi 170° 15' West.

August

Thursday 28

These 24 Hours Commences with strong squalls of wind and rain from North East. the wind Variable steering E. of North East. at 3 PM hauled the Main top gallant sail Double Reef the fore top sail. latter part light wind set all sail the watch imployed in repairing sails Lat 31° 20' North Longi 169° 00' West.

August

Friday 29

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from North East all sail set steering E. of East. the Middle part the wind from N. East. latter part squally with rain the watch imployed in repairing sails got an observation. the Longi 168° 00' Lat 30° 20' North

August

Saturday 30

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from E. East and squally attended with rain. at 8 AM hauled the Main top gallant sail Double Reef the fore top sail. at 2 PM. took ship to N. East set the Main sail

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Main top gallant sail East one Reef out the fore top sail latter part light wind from East. Lat 30° 19' North Longi 164° 35' Observations West 20

August

Sunday 31 26

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from East all sail set steering N. East. at 3 PM. took ship to the East wind from N. East. Middle part calm latter part light wind from south West at 4 PM squared the yards set all sail. at 8 PM. saw a large whale going to the Eastward at 8 PM. saw a small whale. the latter Lat North Longi 165° 45' September

Monday 1

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and Variable at 4 PM. took the whale long fin to the North at 8 PM. commenced cutting the wind light and Variable Lat 30° 30' North Longi 165° 39' West.

September

Tuesday 2

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and squally imployed in cutting at 8 PM. finished. set the fore sail commenced bailing long to the North East with Cloud Reef Main top sail and fore fore sail. Middle part light wind and pleasant. latter part the same. set the fore top sail. Mizen. do imployed in bailing September

Wednesday 3. Lat 30° 50' North Longi 164° 00' West

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and pleasant. Middle part light squalls of rain. the wind at E. of East. steering North East at 4 PM finished bailing Lat 31° 12' North Longi 166° 40' September

Thursday 4

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from E. of East all sail set steering North East at 2 PM. saw porpoises light wind and pleasant Lat 30° at 8 PM. commenced fending down the oil Lat 31° 30' North Longi 165° 49' West

September

Friday 5

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from south E. of East and pleasant all sail set. steering by the wind N. E. of East. this day altered the state of the weather took in loggers. Middle part light wind and pleasant. latter part do. Lat 32° 14' North Longi 165° 20' West

September

Saturday 6

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from the E. of North East all sail set steering by the wind to the North East. Middle part calm latter light wind from south West. the watch imployed in ship's duty Lat North Longi 165° 00'
