

Ship Phoebe Ann New Bedford 1828

September

Sunday 21

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from south. Commenced at 6 AM Double kept the top sails full the main sail. at 11 AM. Lost kept the main top sail full the fore and mizen top sails and fore sail. the ship to the wind turned the boats up. at 10 AM. Near ship to the East. the wind near to W. West. got the fore sail fore top sail. Last one kept the top sail. Steered East. Light squalls of rain. Lat 30-44 North Longi 152-30 West.

September

Monday 22

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from West. top sails set single kept the top sail Main top gallant sail Main sail and jib. got moderate wind at night squalls full the Main top gallant sail Main sail got fore and mizen top sails. Steering East by North the wind at North N. West. Midpass More moderate got the top sails Double kept at daylight got the Main sail got. the watch employed in ship duty. Lat 31-52 North Longi 155-26 West.

September

Tuesday 23

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind at noon East. the Double kept the top sails the North East. Steering E. fourth East. at 4 PM. got the Main top gallant sail. Latter part Calm at 8 PM. from large whale at 9 AM. toward struck and killed one.

September

Wednesday 24

These 24 Hours Commences with light air from the North West and a heavy swell at 4 PM. took the whale large piece took in for the night. lay to E. East. at daylight called all hands Commenced cutting light wind from W. West. Lat 31-20 North Longi 153-30 West.

September

Thursday 25

These 24 Hours Commences with Moderate wind from W. West. commenced cutting at 4 PM. finished. Near ship to East by fourth Commenced sailing. the Middle part strong wind and variable with light rain. Latter part Calm with a heavy swell from the North west. commenced sailing at 3 PM. at 4 PM. Lat 31-48 North Longi 152-48 West.

September

Friday 26

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and Calm commenced in sailing. at Midnight finished sailing at 4 PM. got the

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Saturday 27

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind with light rain the wind variable. Commenced fourth East by fourth. top sail single kept. Midpass light wind and pleasant all sail set. Latter part light wind from North this day finished sailing. Lat 29-55 North Longi 152-10 West.

September

Sunday 28

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from North and pleasant they Commenced fourth East by East. all sail set Lat 29-09 North Longi 150-23 West.

September

Monday 29

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind and pleasant. Steering 22 East. all sail got the wind from North. at 4 PM. from breeches. Midpass light wind and pleasant wind from North East. all sail got. Commenced fourth East. all hands employed in fitting ship. Lat 28-25 North Longi 149-30 West.

September

Tuesday 30

These 24 Hours Commences with brisk trade from North East. all sail got. Steering fourth this day got up the fore top gallant Mast and got the fore top gallant sail. at 11 PM. finished the top gallant sails. Strong wind from East by fourth. all hands employed in fitting and fitting ship. Lat 26-54 North Longi 144-35 West.

October

Wednesday 1

29 73

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from East. Commenced fourth this day changed the Main top gallant Mast. got up the mizen one and gave. at night single kept the top sails. Light squalls of rain. Midpass light wind. Latter part Do. at 4 PM. put the boat in the water. at the same time from a school of Whales. Commenced catching nothing. the whales going North by West. Commenced bearing but the other boat on the starboard. from Whales at the same time Lat 26-19 North Longi 151-08 West.

October

Thursday 2

30 74

These 24 Hours Commences with brisk wind and pleasant. Whales in sight at Half past nine. Commenced toward struck one and caught one at 3 PM. commenced cutting at 8 PM. finished. Near ship to fourth at the same time from a large whale going to the West.
