steering N & E. Double Reef top sails. Mid part light wind and Rain
at Midnight Rear ship to the E & S at Daylight set all sail
steered South the wind at East. all hands employed in ships duty Lat 7:05
Long 153:30

November 86 Sunday 23

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from South East
and Cloudy. all sail set. steering S & W. at 6 PM took the top
gallant sails Double Reef the top sail took the Main
sail and fore sail. hatter part light wind and Pleasant all sail set
steering South the wind at E & S. Lat 6:09 North Long 153:35

sail set. steering South. at night took in sail the wind at
