Hauled to the south. at 9 P.M. tack ship to south East. at 1 P.M. tack ship to south at Daylight set all sail. at 9 A.M. fore Serves stand the latitude and Longitude for this Serves. stand lat 00=21 Miles south Longitude 160=18 West.

December Monday 22

These 24 Hours Commences with Moderate wind from East to East all sail set at 2 P.M. tack ship to West. at 6 P.M. furl the light sails single reef the top sail and Main sail at 8 P.M. tack ship to south East by South. at Dark the Land bearing Circumpass E by South. Dist 2 Leagues at 9 P.M. tack ship to south East by South. at 11 P.M. Double Reef the Main top sails at 4 P.M. Near ship to South East at Daylight set the Main sail at 8 A.M. Near ship to south East by South. Lat 00=8 Miles south
December Tuesday 23 Longitude 160=18 West.

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from E West single reef top sails Main top gallant sail set at 6 P.M. fore top gallant sail Main sail give Main top sail. Coast Reef the fore and Main top sail. Day to South by South. at 4 P.M. tack ship to north at 1 P.M. Near ship to south East at Daylight set the top sails single reef set the Main top gallant sail all hand in place in repairing the fore sail. Lat 1=19 south Longitude 160=08 West
December Wednesday 24

These 24 Hours Commences with Moderate wind from E West top sails single reef Main top gallant set at 6 P.M. Bent the fore sail. at 6 P.M. Double reef the top sail and the top allant sail and Main sail. at the same time Near ship to the north at 10 P.M. Near ship to E East. at 12 at night Near ship to West at Daylight Near ship to E East. set the top sails single reef Main sail Main top gallant sail Lat 1=23 south Longitude 159=18 West

These 24 Hours Commences with Moderate wind and pleasant all sail set steering south East the wind E West at 6 P.M. furl the Main sail give top gallant sails. Double reef the top sail tack ship to North at the same time. at Daylight Main sail. at 8 P.M. saw a ship to the north West steering East at 10 P.M. tack ship to south East. Lat 2=38 south Longitude 158=15
December Sunday 28

These 24 Hours Commences with Moderate wind all sail set steering E by East. at 2 P.M. spoke the Barken Oldham of London. Lat North East 1200 Barrels. at night took in sails as usual. at Daylight set all sail steered E by East. the Oldham in company. Lat 3=28 south Longitude 157=48 West.
December Monday 29

These 24 Hours Commences with bad wind from West. all sail set. Course E by East. at night took in sail. at Daylight set all sail steered by the wind at 10 P.M. furl the fore and Main top gallant sail stronger wind from E West. the watch in place in ships Duty
December 30 Tuesday 30 Lat 4=22 south Longitude 157=30 Obs

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from E West at 1 P.M. furl the Main top gallant sail. at night furl the fore and Main sail. Coast Reef the top sails at the same time Near ship to the north at 2 P.M. Near ship to the south Day Made sail of strong wind at 8 P.M. saw a shoal of Whales toward South boats
