Reef the top sails furled the Main sail veard East. at 10 P.M.
veard ship to North West. at 1 P.M. veard ship to East the wind at 11 P.M. at
Daylight Made sail 3 Large part from a grating bird Lat 41° 07' fourth
January Saturday 10 Longi 153-25 West

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind at E East at 6 P.M.
Close Reef top sail furled the Main sail at 11 P.M. tack ship to
North West by West at 1 P.M. veard ship to East at Daylight Main
