Strong wind took in the Steaming sail. Single kept the Main top sail at 3 P.M. hauled the Main top gallant sail. Double kept the fore top sail. at 6 P.M. More moderate. Set Main top gallant sail and Steaming sail latter part Strong wind from West and Pleasant

March Tuesday 10 Lat 38-58 fourth Longi 113-22 West

These 24 Hours Commences with strong wind from North West and Cloud all sail set Coars East by North. at 4 P.M. Double kept the top sails full. the Main sail. at 5 P.M. Boat kept the top sails full. the Main top sail. The wind changed to South West for Single. and Rain. Middle part wind variable Main took sail occasionally

Double kept the top sails full. the Main top sail. Coars East by North. this day bent the fore and Main stay sail. at 3 P.M. hauled the Main top gallant sail at 6 P.M. set a gain latter part Strong wind and Rain at 10 P.M. the wind changed from North West. to South West gradually. Lat 41-22 fourth Longi 101-09 West

March Monday 16

These 24 Hours Commences with Light wind from South West and Rain the top sail single kept. the gig and Main top gallant sail set at 6 P.M. set the fore top Mast Steaming sail. Middle part light wind and variable and Rain latter part the same Lat 41-40 fourth Longi 100-11 West

March Tuesday 17

These 24 Hours Commences with Light wind from South East and Rainy. Middle part light wind from South East and Pleasant at 2 P.M. set the Main sail. Steaming by the wind the watch employed in ships duty Lat 41-51 fourth Longi 99-13 West

March Wednesday 18

These 24 Hours Commences with Light wind from East South East and Pleasant. Middle part Calm. latter part light wind and Pleasant the wind from South West. the watch employed in ships duty Lat 41-23 fourth Longi 98-24 West

March Thursday 19

These 24 Hours Commences with light wind from South West and Pleasant at 4 P.M. set the fore top Mast and Main top gallant Steaming sails at 10 P.M. set the lower Steaming sail latter part fresh breeze from North West. Pleasant the South East by East the watch employed in Steaming the Decks Lat 42-26 fourth Longi 94-09 West
