These twenty four hours commences with light airs from S.W. & all sail set steering South clear weather at 2 PM saw a large ship steering N.W.

middle part the same

Later part passing shoals employed sheathing the deck
Brought on board of bread & filling magazines & barrels
Long for Chronometer 26 08 W. Lat 34 20 N

Remarks Onboard Tuesday July 27th 1847

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from N.W. & all sail set steering South clear & pleasant
employed sheathing decks & working on rigging copper
making hove's cast

middle part the same & royal set. course S.W.

Later part passing shoals of rain & wind
employed at various jobs wind S.E. ends with wind
East steering South

Long 26 40 W.

Lat 33 10 N

Remarks Onboard Wednesday July 28th 1847

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from E.S.E. all sail set steering S.W. clear weather all sail set saw porpoises

middle part the same

ends with fine breezes & clear weather saw 20 whales
employed on rigging & fitting & hove's cast getting ready
for a haul

Long by Meridian Alt of sun Lat 31 38 N
26 20 W

Remarks Onboard Thursday July 29th 1847

These 24 hours commences with moderate breezes from East clear weather all sail set steering South lowered M. Mast for battle without success, after supper the foremast hand out his leg very bad with a knife came off had it sewed up. & hove's cast

middle part the same
but the tides in 33 N

later part fine breezes from N.E. steering North all sail set
people employed at various jobs
Brought on board of flour

Long for Chron 26 10 West. Lat by B. 30 14 North

Remarks Onboard Friday July 31st 1847

These twenty four hours commences with fine breezes from N.E. clear weather steering North all sail set saw whales

middle part the same at midnight steering S.
by M.

ends with light breezes steering S.W.
people employed at various jobs
cut men doing well

Long for Chron. 26 10 West Lat by B. 28 14 North

Remarks Onboard Saturday July 31st 1847

These twenty four hours commences with moderate breezes from E.S.E. all sail set steering S.W. clear weather one sail in sight

middle part the same

ends with moderate breezes veering on hawling from East to S.E. people employ at various jobs
fitted new futtock & hove's cast for main. taffel. hove's cast
rigging made oil lashing
