

Remarks Onboard Monday Sept 6th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with light & baffling winds  
from E to S.E. with passing clouds & rain all sail set  
heading to the N.W. by 12 made ship in sight saw great  
number of porpoises

Middle part the same

Letter part pleasant all sail set heading N.W. by E.  
hook in waist Boat up and her turning in rigging &c  
setting up rigging ship in sight  
Long per chron 27.35 West Lett by Bsd 23 17.2

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Sept 7th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes & pleasant  
all sail set heading N.W. by E. speaker took 3 cloths  
off it made a rose mirror bent it again

Middle part the same winds N.E. by E at midnight  
hook in waist Boat strong breeze double reefed topsails  
by 10 sail

End with strong breezes at daylight struck and one reef at  
8 A.M. set haul topsails & top gallant sail & fly jib at 10 took  
in fly jib one ship in sight

Long per chron 27.50 W. Lett by Bsd 24-31 = South

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Sept 8th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with strong breezes from E & E all  
pleasant sail set heading N.W. saw porpoises & porpoises  
& sail in sight hands employed on rigging  
Middle part strong breezes reefed the topsails  
at daylight made all sail

End with moderate breezes from East 2 sail in  
sight hands employed on rigging

Long per chron 28.34 West Lett 26.54 South

Remarks Onboard Thursday Sept 9th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from E.N.E.  
all sail set heading N.W. E. pleasant employed on rigging  
tarring down 2 sail in sight to windward put out waist Boat  
Hauled up jib

Middle part light breezes from N.E. passing clouds.

Letter part light breezes from N.W. steering N.W. E. employed  
clearing chains & coiling them saw porpoises & one gone

Long per Chron 28.15 West Lett by Bsd 28.15 South

Remarks Onboard Friday Sept 10th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from S.W. pleasant  
all sail set steering N.W. E. employed tarring down & packing  
chains & coiling them

Middle part the same

Letter part light air from West haul sail at hauled  
up 1st mast chain cleaned it oiled it & sundry other jobs  
saw porpoises

Long per Chron 27.35 W. Lett by Bsd 27.36 South

Remarks Onboard Saturday Sept 11th 1847  
These 24 hours begins with light breezes from West to  
N.W. steering N.W. E. all sail set finished chain put it  
below at dusk calm saw porpoises

Middle part cloudy mostly calm

Letter part light air from West employed setting  
up main rigging tarring & coiling chains
