

Remarks Onboard Saturday Sept 18th 1847

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from North steering S.E. by E all sail set fine weather saw finbacks

Middle part the same at daylight passing squalls of rain

Latter part moderate & pleasant sent us fore & after gaff. sent sail this morn
Capt getting better

Long perches 11:46 Lat 35 47 N.

Remarks Onboard Sunday Sept 19th 1847

These 24 hours begins with moderate breezes from North pleasant steering S.E. all sail set this day gave the men 2 gallon of molasses for one month

Middle part the same steering S.E. by E

Ends rather very light air from N.W.

Long perches Lat 36 54

Remarks Onboard Monday Sept 20th 1847

These 24 hours begins with light air from N.W. all sail set steering S.E. by E accompanied with light squalls of rain

Middle part the same at daylight commenced breaking out water & bread

at 10 AM saw 3 whales breared for them chased to so far as whales went off to the N.W.

Long 1630 N

Lat 37 00 N by R. 37.00

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Sept 21st 1847

These 24 hours begins with calm & light air from N.E. some S.E. beautiful weather saw nothing more

Middle part clear & light breezes from North

Latter part fine breezes from N.W. steering S.E. by E. saw finbacks & killed people employed making scrub brooms

Long perches 14:45 N. Lat 37 36 N

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Sept 22nd 1847

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.E. by E all sail set saw killers & finbacks cloudy weather has the appearance of a gale

Middle part strong breezes from West that in 1/2 day all sail set single reef. rain severely at daylight set main & 2nd sail at 7 PM sent down fore top gallant yard
Latter part light breezes accompanied with fog & rain made short sail steering S.E. by N.

Long perches by R. 13:20 N. Lat 38 20 N

Remarks Onboard Thursday Sept 23rd 1847

These 24 hours begins with light breezes from West accompanied with fog & rain steering S.E. all pendant sail set along reef & main & 2nd sail

Middle part the same

Latter part fog at intervals steering S.E. killed people employed making brooms
