These 24 hours commences with fine breezes from the N. steering S.E. at Meridian saw 2 whales
whales hauled for them to N. purpose saw fin backs
at dusk hauled up E. Wall sail mired S.W.

Middle part the same weather mired S.W.

latter part the same saw 2 whales

Long by R. 5-10 M. Lat by B. 37-02

Remarks Onboard Friday, Oct. 1st 1847-

Commences with fresh breezes from N.E. cloudy
all sail set steering E.S.E. upwind also fore top
gallant sail hauled up & sent up good set sail saw nothing

Middle & latter part the same saw 2 whales
winds more easterly some rain. So Ends

Long by R. 1-20 West Lat by B. 37-15

Remarks Onboard Saturday, Oct. 2nd 1847-

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from N.E.
ship heading S.E. by E all sail set cloudy weather
killed a large dog to day about 100 pounds of fat

Middle & latter part the same at daylight
saw 2 whales hauled for them off wind
on & started to N. purpose saw 3 or 4 more went
on to them to N. purpose
this ends chasing whales

Long per chron. at 3-10 Lat by B. 38-35

Remarks Onboard Sunday, Oct. 3rd 1847

These 24 hours begins with fresh breezes from N.E. by E.
saw 2 whales & some fin backs cruising at 3-4 M.
put ship's head to S.W. & E. all prudent sail set

Middle & latter part more moderate at daylight
made all sail pleasant. saw some fin backs
at 10 M. took 2 Lunar Observation
So Ends

Long per Lunar. 25 miles East of ship
Lat by B. 38-56 North
Long 3-45 East.

Remarks Onboard Monday, Oct. 4th 1847-

These 24 hours begins with fine breezes from N.E. all sail
set steering E.S.E. pleasant. saw fin backs at dusk comes in cloudy

Middle part the same with a steady sea falling

latter part fine weather & breeze from N.W. cloudy at
dusk saw Blackfish hauled the boats got one to each
boat took them in thus ends

Long by R. 6-10 East Lat by B. 39-15 N.

Remarks Onboard Tuesday, Oct. 5th 1847-

This day begins with fine breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E.
all sail set cloudy with rain employed clearing away
Blackfish

Middle part the same with rain
at daylight winds shifted to W. and hawling to S.W.E.

latter part the same ends with winds North
