

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Oct 6th 1847.
Commenced with fresh breezes from South ship
heading ESE on a wind with thick rainy weather
all prudent sail set.

Middle part the same at 2 P.M. clears up.
double reef the topsails took in jib & main sail

Later part moderate gales from South & passing
squalls to Ende.

Long per Chem 16.00 East. Lat. by Bs 38.11 South

Remarks Onboard Thursday Oct 7th 1847
Commenced with fresh gales from South & passing
squalls all prudent sail set steering E by S.

Middle & later part fresh gales and passing
squalls of hail & rain saw several
finbacks employed taking in & making sail
as occasion requires double reef & courses set

Long per Chem 16.56 West Lat. by Bs 37.20 South

Remarks Onboard Friday Oct 8th 1847.
Commenced with violent breezes from South & passing
squalls of wind & hail & rain all prudent sail
set steering ESE at dusk winds incline more
easterly.
Middle part fresh breezes with strong flaws at 11 A.M.
tacked ship heading NW by N. at daylight made all
sail at 7 P.M. put ship's head East by N. with strong breeze
took in topgallant sail & fly jib commenced heeling
black fish saw finbacks
this day Ende sailing

Long per Chem 15.44 East Lat. by Bs 36.40

Remarks Onboard Saturday Oct 9th 1847.
Commenced with fresh breezes from S by E with strong flaws.
Ship heading to the Eastward on a wind at 2 A.M. finished heeling
black fish saw finbacks

Middle part strong breezes at 10 A.M. double reef the topsails
were ship heading NW by N. wind V.E.

Later part the same passing clouds saw finbacks
broke out one barrel of beef & 200 lbs coffee
200 lbs ship's head. V.P. Variation 2 1/2 points

Long per Chem 16.20 W Lat. by Bs 36.55 South.

Remarks Onboard Sunday October 10th 1847
Commenced with strong breezes from V.E. pleasant ship head
NW under double reef topsails with a head sea & strong motion by
current
Middle part the same took in main sail & jib
close reef fore topsail at daylight set things again.
Later part more moderate saw several finbacks
winds incline more southerly ship head NW by N.

Long per Chem 16.42 W Lat. by Bs 38.11 South

Remarks Onboard Monday Oct 11th 1847.
Commenced with strong breezes from V.E. with pleasant
weather all prudent sail set heading V.P. sent 2 men
to mast head & bows for fighting

Middle part fresh gales took in sail at daylight set fore
topsail at 2 P.M. took it in

Ende with strong gales from V.E. ship lying too head
V.P. 40
