

Remarks Onboard Tuesday October 12th 1847

Commences with strong gales from N.W. & passing squalls ship laying to heading to the S.W. under close reefed main & fore top sails at dusk hauled up & to hauls (boat)

Middle part the same

Later part more moderate at 4 P.M. wore ship head East. - End -

Long per Chem 16 11 East Lat by Obs 39 44 South

Remarks Onboard Wednesday October 13th 1847

These 24 hours begins with fresh gales from N.W. & cloudy ship laying to heading & employed making out (boat) & water

Middle part moderates at daylight made sail heading East at 8 A.M. struck out reef

Ends with light air from South

Long by Reck 16 15 E Lat by Obs 39 35 South

Remarks Onboard Thursday Oct 14th 1847

Commences with light airs from N.W. made all sail at 2 A.M. steering E.S.E. cloudy weather saw one porpoise

Middle part winds from N.W. steering S.E. by E. with 2 fresh breezes

Later part light breezes from N.W. with employes clearing ward-lar-gear

Long per Chem 17 08 E Lat by Obs 39 35 South

Remarks Onboard Friday Oct 15th 1847

Commences with light breezes from N.W. all sail set steering N.E. by E. at 2 A.M. comes on severe rain with the wind shifting from N.W. to South & at 4 took in top gallant sails & single reef the topsails

Middle part violent squalls from the N.W. & double reef the topsails at daylight moderates winds West

Later part strong breezes & passing squalls at daylight made all sail steering E.D.E.

Ends with the winds N.W.

Long per Chem 20 40 East Lat by Obs 39 11 South

Remarks Onboard Saturday October 16th 1847

Commences with moderate gales from N.W. passing squalls of wind & rain at 2 A.M. furled main sail took in fore top gallant sail at 4 o'clock took in waist Boat at dusk dunnage reef the topsails set main top gallant sail set quarter Boats on upper exains

Middle part the same with much hawking to boat at midnight took in main top gallant sail double reef the topsails

Later part more moderate at daylight struck out one reef set main sail & jib saw an English Hart exchanged anchors with her steering E.S.E. passed her at 2 P.M. at 10 P.M. struck out reef

Long per Chem 23 44 East Lat by Obs 38 55 South

Ends with wind N.W.

Remarks Onboard Sunday Oct 17th 1847

Commences with strong breezes from N.W. & passing squalls steering E.S.E. at 1 A.M. made all sail English Hart & miles at stern - gave the men the molasses this day

Middle part fresh breezes & at 8 A.M. wore haul of N.E. took in top gallant sails

Ends with fresh breezes & clear weather winds N.E. by E. ship heading E.S. on 8 wind

Long per Chem 27 10 East Lat by Obs 23 1/4 points West by
