 & pleasant all sail set steering E by N saw great
 number of finbacks at 6 A.M. saw 1 sail on our lee

Middle & latter part. light breezes from N & E
 steering East untill 1 P.M. then E by N. saw
 finbacks for an hour & half

 Commenced with light breezes from N & E pleasant all
 sail set steering E by N. saw great number of finbacks

Remarks Onboard Wednesday November 3rd 1847
 Commenced with fine breezes from N & E all sail
 set steering E & E pleasant saw finbacks at dusk took
 in sail set boats crew watches steering N & E
 Middle part thick fog A.M. winds hauled to S & E
 heaved up heading to the East
 at daylight made sail saw finbacks
 latter part fresh breezes from S & E. cracking standing
 Boat & crew

Long per chron 61-49 East Lat by Obs 33-01 South

Remarks Onboard Thursday Nov 4th 1847
 Commenced with fresh breezes from S & E ship heading
 to the N & E. at 4 P.M. took ship heading N by N
 at dusk took in sail

Middle part the same at daylight made all sail
 commenced breaking out Breast & water
 saw finbacks

No ends ship heading South winds E & E
