

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Nov. 17th 1847

Commenced with light breezes from S.W. with
fading squalls of fog saw several finbacks going
to windward - at dusk double reefed the topsails

Middle & latter part fine weather at day light
made all sail stood to the Eastward until
7 P.M. took ship steering west as ends
Broke out water
caught a porpoise

Long 73-18 East Lat 33 08 N

Remarks Onboard Thursday Nov 18th 1847

Commenced with fine breezes from North all sail
set steering West pleasant at 3 P.M. saw one
right whale lunged for him to no purpose at dusk
took in sail heading N.W.

Middle part strong breezes from S.W. heavy
at daylight set double reefed main sail & 1st
steering west at 7 P.M. saw whals lowered for them
to no purpose came on board took in sail close reef
main top sail so ends the whals close to the
ship working to N.W.

Long 72-09 E Lat 33 15 N

Remarks Onboard Friday Nov 19th 1847

Commenced with fresh gale from North thick weather
driving to the east at 4 P.M. winds shifted
to N.W. with rain at dusk wore ship set watch
heading N.W.

Middle part squally at daylight set double reef.

Ends more moderate ship heading S.E. on 2nd day
Clear

Long 72-16 E Lat 33 04 N

Remarks Onboard Saturday Nov 20th 1847

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. cruising
under short sail at 4 P.M. took ship saw one whale come up
in ship's wake galed him went to windward at dusk double
reef ran off at 8 P.M. for the night
Middle part moderate at daylight made all sail
saw finbacks at 7 P.M. took ship heading to the S.E.
Broke out 2 lbs of sweet sugar apples & small stores

Long 71-42 East Lat 33 02 N

Remarks Onboard Sunday Nov 21st 1847

Commenced with fine breezes from West heading
to the N.W. at dusk double reefed the topsails but
ships head N.W. caught a porpoise

Middle & latter part fine breezes at daylight made
all sail at 7 P.M. saw several whals lowered for them
to no purpose whals very wild could not get fast
at ends

Long 72 04 E Lat 33 42 N

Remarks Onboard Monday Nov 22nd 1847

Commenced with fine breezes & pleasant winds N.W. ship
heading S.W. at dusk took in sail saw a humpback
Bry heading S.W.

Middle part the same at daylight made all sail
saw a B. h. steering East at 7 P.M. put ship
head to S.W. saw finbacks
thus ends

Long 71-45 East Lat 32-22 N
