

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Nov. 23rd 1847

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.W. & pleasant all sail set steering S.W. by W. saw a number of porpoises commenced standing haul. watched middle part very moderate hauled upon a wind until daylight with canvas up. at daylight bore of S.W. saw a merchantman steering East. Latter part fresh breezes & heavy saw porpoises

Long 21-11 East Lat by Obs 33 38 South

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Nov. 24th 1847

Commenced with fresh breezes & passing squalls of fog at 2 A.M. saw a Right whale among porpoises lowered to so purpose at dusk took in sail several whales in sight. Middle & latter part moderate winds hauled to N.W. at daylight made all sail save nothing but forebacks. Ends cruising off and on wind at dawn bore up N.W. by W.

Long per chron 71-30 E. Lat by Obs 33-56 S

Remarks Onboard Thursday Nov. 25th 1847

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. & smoky steering S.W. saw nothing broke out water filled & cast of salt water at dusk took in sail close reef main topsail middle part fresh breezes steering S.W. by E. at daylight set double reef topsails at 8 P.M. thick with rain took in sail.

Ends moderate made sail single reef main at 11 P.M. caught a porpoise.

Long 71-48 E Lat 34-36 S

Remarks Onboard Friday Nov. 26th 1847

Commenced with fine breezes from S.W. smoky weather with a large swell running from N.W. at dusk were ship heading West took in sail middle part light air from S.W. at daylight made all sail winds shift to East steering S.W. by W. at 9 P.M. saw a merchantman hauled Eastward.

Ends with moderate breezes from S.E. & heavy large swell running from N.W. saw a to hales

Long per chron 72-05 East Lat by Obs 36-04 S

Remarks Onboard Saturday Nov. 27th 1847

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. all sail set steering S.W. saw nothing at dusk took in all sail but close reef main topsail winds hauled more latter by cloudy middle part thick steering N.W. by W. at daylight set double reef topsails & fore sail blowing a fresh gale. Latter part fresh gales & sunshine from S.W. at 11 P.M. took in & close reef main topsail.

Long per chron 71-30 East Lat by Obs 37-50 South

Remarks Onboard Sunday Nov. 28th 1847

Commenced with fresh gales from S.W. ship lay by the heading Westward standing by the crew.

Middle part moderate with rain at daylight set double reef topsails.

at dusk a to hales Latter part more moderate made all sail heading to the S.W. by W.

Long 70-45 E Lat 38-24 S
