

Remarks Onboard Monday Nov. 29th 1847

Commenced with moderate gales from N.W. at 4 AM took in fore top sail & in main sail close reefed top sail at 6 AM took in fore sail hoisted up lee back set with

Middle part strong gales at 9 AM were ship heading North

Later part the same with passing squalls laying the heading to the S.W. & West

Long per. chm 71-10 East Lett by Obs 38 31 South

Remarks Onboard Tuesday, Dec 30th 1847

Commenced with strong gales from N.W. & with clear weather & a tremendous sea running

Middle part the same at daylight set double reef top sails main sail

Later part strong breezes & passing squalls at 10 PM took in main sail winded with N.W. steering N.W.

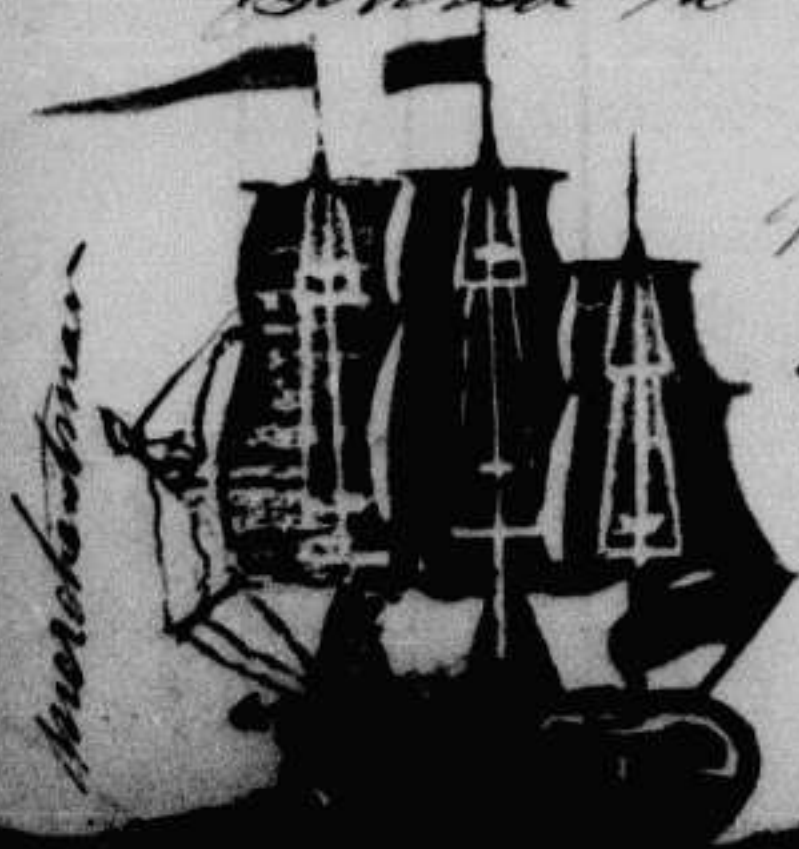
Remarks Onboard Wednesday Dec 31st 1847

Commenced with strong winds from N.W. & passing squalls ship heading N.W. pleasant at 4 AM saw 2 sails steering East spoke ship Manchester of London Bound to Calcutta long 67 30 East at dusk took in sail

Middle part moderate breezes at daylight made all sail commenced breaking up out Bread & water later part calm took 2 Lines On.

Remarks Onboard Thursday Dec. 29 1847

Commenced with light airs from N.W. heading N.W. pleasant at dusk double reefed the top sails saw great quantity of seals feed & up fish out new gird for cutting gear

Middle part the same at daylight made all sail winds from N.W. steering N.W.

Later part breezes increase with passing squalls of -

Remarks Onboard Friday, Dec. 31st 1847

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. steering N.W. at dusk took in sail & close reefed main top sail

Middle & later part variable weather moderate fresh gales with rain here & there at 8 PM winds shifted to N.W. made sail Ends mottled at meridian struck out the reef heading N.W. by N.W.

fine weather & so fresh

Remarks Onboard Saturday Dec. 4th 1847

Commenced with light airs from N.W. & pleasant heading N.W. at dusk took in sail was ship heading to the N.W.

Middle part strong breezes at daylight set double reef top sails commenced breaking out meet brock 2 lbs at 8 PM made all sail

Ends more moderate
