

Remarks Onboard Sunday Dec 5th 1847

Commenced with fine weather winds N.W. steering W.M. at dusk double reefed the topsails took in jib

Middle part moderate at daylight made all sail
latter part breezes freshen to S.W. took in main
to gallant sail double reefed the fore topsail

O's Ends

Long 68° 50' East Lat by Obs 44° 11' 0

Remarks Onboard Monday Dec 6th 1847

Commenced with fresh gales from S.W. & heavy
steering W.M. at 5 A.M. sent down main top gallant
yard hoisted up Breeze both in fore & main passed close reef
main hove too heading N.E.

Middle & latter part moderate at daylight
made all sail repaired old main top gallant sail
but it sent the yards aloft

Ends with good weather winds North

Long 68° 10' E Lat by Obs 45° 10' 0

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Dec 7th 1847

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. heavy steering W
at 4 A.M. put in sail at 6 close reefed main top sail & fore
sail hove too heading East

Middle & latter part violent gales from N.W. to
S.W. with passing squalls at 7 P.M. took in main topsail
some rain & snow with a violent sea running

Long 70° 20' E Lat 45° 29' 0

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Dec 8th 1847

Commenced with violent gale from W.W. steering to
heading W.W. at 4 A.M. moderates at 6 A.M. set main
topsail

Middle part moderates at daylight winds haul to
S.W. at 2 P.M. set double reef were ship heading W.W. at
10 P.M. took in sail close reef main topsail

Ends with violent gales from N.W.
saw 2 pinheads

Long by Reb 71° 30' E Lat by Obs 45° 20' 0

Remarks Onboard Thursday Dec 9th 1847

Commenced with violent gale from S.W. inclining
to the S.W. at 6 A.M. were ship took in main topsail
heading S.W. & saw a shoal of black fish
middle part violent gales & tremendous squalls

latter part more moderate winds S.W. ship head
West & West

Lat 45° 25' 0
Long 71° 12' E

Remarks Onboard Friday Dec 10th 1847

Commenced with violent gale from S.W. with a squall
laying to heading W.W. at 4 A.M. set main topsail

Middle part moderates at dusk ship heading N.W.
at daylight set double reef topsails put ships head
to S.W. at 10 o'clock were ship heading W.W. moderates
made all sail thus Ends
