

Remarks Onboard Saturday Dec. 11th 1847

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W. & rising clouds ship heading west all sail set saw nothing but birds at dusk took in sail
middle part moderate at daylight made all sail

latter part fine weather saw porpoises several employed breaking out water at meridian were ship heading N.W.

Long per char 77 13 E Lat by Obs 45 14 S

Remarks Onboard Sunday Dec 12th 1847

Commenced with fine weather winds ex. N.W. ship steering N.W. by N. saw nothing at dusk took in sail
middle part strong breeze from N.W. at daylight so made up to 8 P.M. made all sail

Ends with thick fog & moderate saw one fur back

Long per char 77 10 E Lat by Obs 47 12 S

Remarks Onboard Monday Dec 13th 1847

Commenced with thick fog at 11 A.M. took in sail at 2 A.M. clear away winds heel to W. made all sail saw nothing at sunset took in sail steering N.E. for the night

middle part calm at daylight made all sail with light air from E.S.E. commenced breaking out after haul for flour & various other jobs

thus Ends

Long 70 24 East

Lat by Obs 47 38

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Dec 14th 1847

Commenced with light air from East. took ship heading west at 2 P.M. came on thick with rain at 6 A.M. took in sail bore up N.W. with close reef main topmast & foresail

middle & latter part moderate gales accompanied with thick fog and rain from N.E. at 11 P.M. took in fore sail
at fore spoke thus Ends heading N.W. Variation 3 points
Lat by 2 points

Long by reckoning 77 30 E Lat by Obs 47 10 S

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Dec 15th 1847

Commenced with moderate gales from N.E. accompanied with thick fog and rain at 6 A.M. put boats on upper crews took in main topsail heading N.W.

middle part violent gales winds heel to N.W. at 3 P.M. bore ship heading E.S. Ends clear with violent gales & tremendous sea running from N.W.

Long at 10 15 East Lat by Obs 47 30 S

Remarks Onboard Thursday Dec 16th 1847

Commenced with violent gales from N.W. accompanied with tremendous sea from N.W. & clear weather ship's head E.S. under spencers & fore topmast staysail main topsail furl'd at 4 A.M. at main topmast moderate
middle part violent squalls of wind & snow at daylight took in main topsail

latter part the same

Long 67 45 E

Lat 47 11

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
