

Remarks on Board Wednesday, Dec 29th 1847

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. & accompanied with thick fog heading S.W. at dusk took in sail at 2 A.M. struck a porpoise lost him middle & latter part moderate gales from S.W. & E. with thick fog ship heading S.W.

Long per chron 68 31 East Lat by Obs 46 31 S.

Remarks Onboard Thursday, Dec 30th 1847

Commenced with moderate gales from N.E. & accompanied with thick fog ship heading S.W. laying too at 3 A.M. caught a porpoise middle & latter part the same long 68 40 E. Lat 46 48

Remarks Onboard Friday, Dec 31st 1847

Commenced with thick fog & strong breezes from N.E. ship laying too heading S.W. middle part the same the same heading S.W. by W.

Long per chron 68 45 E. Lat by Obs 47 03 S. by Reck

Remarks Onboard Saturday, Jan 1st 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. & accompanied with thick fog ship laying too heading S.W. at 3 A.M. were ship heading N.E. by E. winds light & large swell running from N.E.

Middle part the same at 8 P.M. put ship head S.W. & at 10 P.M. clear up got a Lunar Obs. Broke out 2 lbs of meat & was pleasant set fore & aft.

Long per Chron 67 01 East
by Lunar 67 23 East

Lat by Obs 46 47 South

Remarks Onboard Sunday, Jan 2nd 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. & smoke & wave ship run off N.W. & saw a fin back at dusk took in fore topsail & foresail.

Middle part winds haul. to windward strong at 6 P.M. put ship head to South.

latter part the same steering to the N.W. & E. by day at noon saw humpbacks & copper off Duty sick.

Long per Chron 67 58 East Lat by Obs 47 08 South

Remarks Onboard Monday, Jan 3rd 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. & rugged & cloudy saw great number of humpbacks passed for a cow & calf to N.W. & purpose steering to the S.W. & E. at dusk took in sail heading S.W. copper sick has been 4 days off Duty.

Middle part moderate at daylight made sail & was S.W. & E. cruising & was with thick fog & rain took in sail heading S.W. by W.

Long 68 45

Lat. Red Obs 47 03 S.

Remarks Onboard Tuesday, Jan 4th 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from North laying with close reef main topsail & others heading N.W. & N. Variation 34 Degrees Easterly copper same better.

Middle & latter part variable from gales the fog heading N.W. & E. was clear laying too.

Long 68 12 East

Lat. 47 23 S.
