

Remarks On Board Monday Jan 17th 1848

Commenced with light breezes from S.E. & pleasant
employed working to windward on short tack up to Amsterdam
middle part moderate breeze & buffing at daylight
Amsterdam bearing E by S 22 miles Dist ship sailing
in shore winds S.W. saw 2 ships to windward at 9 o'clock
2 boats went in shore fishing & exchanged cables with ship
(later part cloudy 3 boats in shore fishing)
saw the west side of the land on fire above 2 volcanoes
thus ends

Long per chron 77° 25' East Lat by Obs 35° 00' South

Remarks On Board Tuesday Jan 18th 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. 3 boats
in shore fishing came off & sunset caught about 10 lbs
of fish saw 8 or 10 lights on shore apparently fires kindled
by some one on shore hoisted up boats here up E by S.
made all sail
middle part fresh breezes & pleasant steering East
at 8 A.M.
latter part moderate & pleasant employed cleaning
fish & salting them sunset 8 o'clock thus ends

Long 77° 45' East Lat by Obs 37° 14' S

Remarks On Board Wednesday Jan 19th 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. & pleasant
& pleasant steering East all sail set - gale light setting 35
had stage & 16 8/16 gals at dusk wind hauled to
N.W.

Middle & latter part light air from West
people employed fitting fore top gallant gear bent
sail sent fore aft on board 1/2 gals Painted keel

Long 81° 00' East Lat by Obs 36° 42' S

Remarks On Board Thursday Jan 20th 1848

Commenced with light air from West steering E by S. pleasant
people employed at various jobs painted spanker boom & stern and grapples
middle part calm

latter part moderate breeze from North at daylight sunset 6
repaired it bent 1/2 & 1/2 gals caught 10 porpoise
thus ends



Long per chron 82° 10' East Lat by Obs 36° 26' S

Remarks On Board Friday Jan 21st 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from North all sail set
steering E by S sunset main topsail bent old and hands
employed at various jobs on rigging

middle part calm

latter part light air from N.W. steering E by S.
sunset better & sunset resailed 2 lbs of fish

Long per chron 82° 45' East Lat by Obs 35° 59' South

Remarks On Board Saturday Jan 22nd 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.W. pleasant
steering E by S saw porpoises people employed cleaning
iron work around the ship

middle part the same

latter part the same saw 2 sulphur bottomers hauled
for one of them employed painting boats over head &
bleaching iron work

Long 83° 20' East Lat 35° 13' S
