

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 4th 1848

Commenced with light airs from South ship head. E.V.E. by the wind saw no whales ship this in sight middle part light breeze from S. & ship head 20. M. at day light made sail latter part fine weather here up with wind 20 M at 9 P.M. passed the seal steaming 20 20 Ends
Long 110-00 East. Lat 23 19 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 5th 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds V.E. steering South at dusk took in sail heading 100 M. middle & latter part fine steering 10 to 20 V. ship head & Edward Coggeshall Master 160 f. sperm 20 & ends
Lat 26 40

Remark On Board Thursday April 6th 1848

Commenced with fine weather steering South & ship in company at dusk took in sail middle part the same middle & latter part the same all sail set cruising 2 sail in sight Long Lat 26 13 N

Remark On Board Friday April 7th 1848

Commenced with light breezes from V.E. & pleasant cruising at 4 AM spoke ship Cherson of S. S. Bedford 30 mont out 130 M. 60 f. sperm at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same ship steering to the West 20 Ends

Long 107 30 Lat 26 15

Remarks On Board Saturday April 8th 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds V.E. steering to the West in company with the sloop exchanged 2 Barrel of Pork with them for 2 cwt of Bread at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same run off to W. 20 Ends saw nothing Lat 25 58 Long 108 55

Remarks On Board Sunday April 9th 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds V.E. ship steering to W. at dusk took in sail light breeze becoming V.W. middle & latter part fresh breezes cruising 20 Ends heading E. V.E. Lat 25 38
Long 107 48

Remarks On Board Monday April 10th 1848

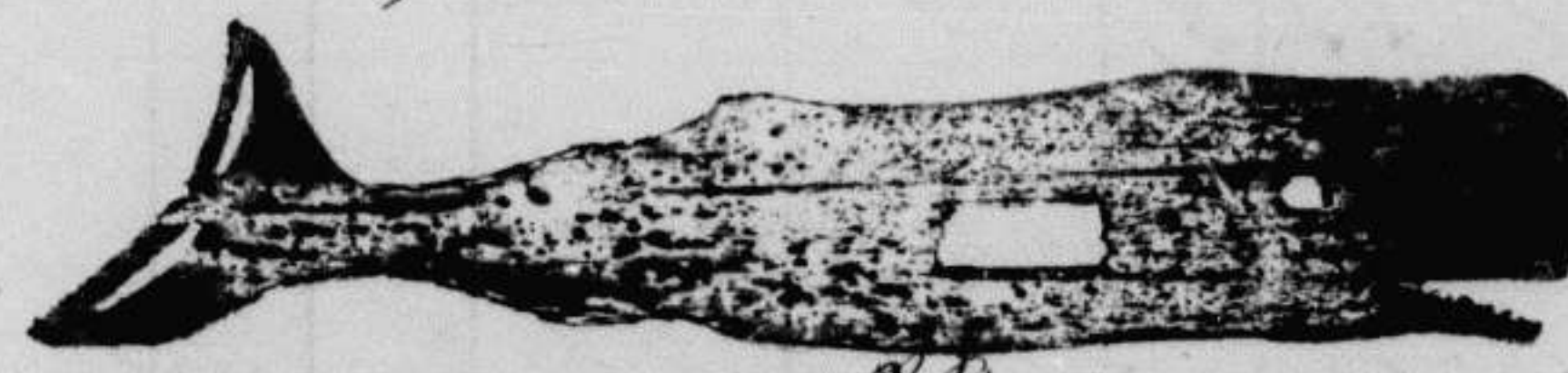
Commenced with fresh breezes from V.E. cloudy ship head E.V.E. all prudent sail set at dusk took in sail heading to V.W. middle & latter part strong breezes & squally ship cruising under double reef to sails one sail in sight
Long 118 00 E. Lat 25 20 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 11th 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from V.E. all prudent sail set heading to the wind to E. spoke young Phoenix & Michael master 41 months out 1830 sperm at dusk took in sail middle & latter part strong breezes from V.E. & passing squally Phoenix in sight heading to W. rugged weather saw 2 finbacks 20 Ends
Long 108 20 E. Lat 24 44 N

Remark On Board Wednesday April 12th 1848

Commenced with strong breezes & squally double reef to topsails got heading E.E. at 2 AM saw sperm whales hauled further. At Boat struck below along side made him fast took in sail middle part the same



saw 20 whales

latter part more moderate at daylight commenced cutting finish at 11 AM. made sail 20 Ends

Remarks On Board Thursday April 13th 1848

Commenced with fine weather ship heading V.W. employed Boiling at dusk took in sail headed East winds V.E. middle part & latter part the same all prudent sail set & boiling quenching 8 20 Ends Long 108 55 E Lat 24 07

Remarks On Board Friday April 14th 1848

Commenced with fine breezes from V.E. clear ship heading E. employed Boiling finished at dusk took in 20 f. whole finnet & latter part strong breezes ship heading E. employed slowing down saw 2 Boat struck main beam

Long 108 55 East
