

Remarks On Board Saturday April 14th 1848

Commenced with strong trades from S.E. all prudent sail set heading E. & finished blowing down at 3 1/2 AM. Saw skin & bones low down for them to do purpose at dusk took in sail & started after them going NW. middle part.

fine weather latter part the same saw 4 whales and 1 seal. Long 109 20- Lat 23 27 N

Remarks On Board Sunday April 15th 1848

Commenced with fine weather. Saw 2 whales & 1 seal. Passers of New Bedford 17 months out 700 lbs. at dusk took in sail heading E. & middle & latter part the same saw jumpers do ends

Remarks On Board Monday April 16th 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. & S.W. 2 AM. ref. the topsails saw nothing at dusk took in sail heading E. & middle & latter part violent trades ship heading E. & broke out latter employed getting and gear for the 4th Boat Long 110-20 E Lat 22-39 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 18th 1848

Commenced with violent trades from N.E. ship heading E. & the wind employed at various jobs at dusk took in sail heading NW. middle & latter part more moderate saw 2 whales employed getting ready to put out Bow Boat Long 107-45 East Lat 22-43

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 17th 1848

Begins as usual with winds N.E. & S.W. employed at various jobs at dusk took in sail heading NW. middle & latter part fine breezes & pleasant saw no whales employed putting Bow Boat Long 107-10 Lat 23-15 N

Remarks On Board Thursday April 18th 1848

Commenced with fine weather & moderate S.E. trades saw nothing at dusk took in sail heading NW. middle & latter part the same all sail set do ends

Remarks On Board Friday April 21st 1848

Commenced with fine weather ship heading NW. saw nothing employed at various jobs at dusk double reefed the topsails heading East middle & latter part strong breezes saw 2 whales

Remarks On Board Saturday April 22nd 1848

Commenced with strong breezes & clear weather heading E. & all prudent sail set at dusk took in sail heading NW. middle & latter part the same saw 2 whales suppose to be jumpers do ends

Remarks On Board Sunday April 23rd 1848

Commenced with strong trades & squally all prudent sail set ship heading NW. the wind at dusk took in sail middle part strong squalls with lightning latter part moderate gales thus ends Long 108 34 E Lat 24-01 N

Remarks On Board Monday April 24th 1848

Commenced with strong winds & heavy squalls from N.E. ship heading NW. the wind under double reef at dusk took in sail middle part the same at daylight made sail saw 2 whales at 10 PM put the Bow Boat out do ends ship head N.E. & took 2 Lower Oars Long 108-15 Lat 24-23 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 25th 1848

Commenced with fresh winds from NW. clear saw 2 whales back finished Bow Boat gear at dusk took in sail heading NW. middle & latter part fine weather heading to westward and saw 2 whales do ends Long 108 10 East Lat 24-24 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 26th 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from NW. ship heading to NW. at 4 PM the boat ship heading N.E. at dusk took in sail middle & latter part fine breezes all sail set at day light at 10 PM saw 2 whales about 1000 & 2000 fathoms saw 20 more of them employed hunting Bow Boat 22 E
