

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 9th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales from V.E. clear ship steering
at 11 A.M. until dusk took in & hove too head to E.E. middle & latter
part the same laying too heading E.H. & saw nothing
Long per Line 108 41 East Lat 23 40 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday May 10th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales from V.E. lay too too
head E.E. middle & latter part the same to day, at
dusk fore top sail at 3 P.M. spoke the Usard & other sails in sight
saw 2 foremast ends heading E.E.
Long 107 10 East Lat 23 11 North

Remarks On Board Thursday May 11th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales & passing squalls from V.E.
took in fore top sail at 1 P.M. no sail in sight at dusk close reefed
middle & latter part more moderate heading to W.E.
under short sail Long 108 30 E Lat 23 10 North

Remarks On Board Friday May 12th 1848

Commenced with strong trades from V.E. ship head W.N.
at 11 A.M. were ship heading East at dusk took in fore top sail & jib
middle & latter part the same all prudent sail set & sail
in sight

Long 109 15 Lat 22 32

Remarks On Board Saturday May 13th 1848

Commenced with strong trades & squalls cruising sea
at dusk spoke Bark Endeavor of Sir Beedford
middle & latter part the same ship heading E.H. & saw nothing
but ship to Endeavor Long 110 10 East Lat 22 28 North

Remarks On Board Sunday May 14th 1848

Commenced with strong trades & passing squalls fore ships head
to V.W. N. at dusk took in fore top sail middle & latter part
ship heading South winds more to Eastward & sails in sight
at dusk Long 109 00 Lat 23 02

Remarks On Board Monday May 15th 1848

Commenced with violent trades more to E. ship heading V.
by the wind & sail in sight took in the jib left all prudent sail
for the night middle & latter part fine weather saw several foremast
saw 2 ships Long 107 30 Lat 23 37 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 16th 1848

Commenced with fine weather saw foremast ends V.E. saw 2 ships
at dusk shortened sail heading to V.W. without fore top sail
middle & latter part strong breezes heading V.W. saw nothing
clouds reefed the topsails & Enes

Long 107 40

Lat 24 36

Remarks On Board Wednesday May 17th 1848

Commenced with strong trades from E.E. ship heading
V.E. saw nothing at dusk took in sail were ship heading E. & saw
myself, back off & came hands 851 middle & latter part
middle & headed to E. at daylight made all sail heading V.W.
so Enes nothing in sight Long 107 35 E Lat 24 37 N

Remarks On Board Thursday May 18th 1848

Commenced with fine weather heading V.W. & N. saw nothing
at dusk shortened sail middle & latter part light air & calm
heading to the North saw 2 Bark ahead Employed Bleaching
iron Bark overhauling jib gugs &c
Long 107 12 Lat 24 09

Remarks On Board Friday May 19th 1848

Commenced with calm clear sea & sail & 50 wheels people at
work at various jobs at dusk took in sail middle & latter part
few breezes from V.E. ship heading E.H. employed at various jobs
unbent fore spence & Enes Long 107 15 Lat 24 26 N

Remarks On Board Saturday May 20th 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds veering around to V.W. at dusk
spoke Bark Strato 300 lbs from middle & latter part light wind
from V.W. Bark in sight steering to the V.E. so Enes
