

Remarks On Board Saturday June 24th 1848

Begins with fresh breezes & cloudy employed starting & weather in the fore
hull & filling sails with the middle part the moderate & cloudy
at daylight we call it all hands get ready for sea sent up main
top gallant & end stowed & toward anchor at 10 PM took the anchor
and the sea steering with left the habit anchor so Ends
Long 116 20 East Lat 20 19 N

Remarks On Board Sunday June 25th 1848

Begins with fine breezes & cloudy hands E.W.E. steering with employed
starting & anchors at 2 AM some hands were a for them to go pass
at 5 AM lost sight of the land at dark left water middle
part the same situation. haul catches latter part & long wind
at 8 PM saw a sperm whale going quick to under water made
several licks for him to go past the bow at 8 PM so Ends
Long 116 11 Lat 18 35 N

Remarks On Board Monday June 26th 1848

Begins with strong winds from N.E. & passing clouds ship course
south middle & latter part fine weather and a whale took a
small one
Long 116 10 Lat 18 58 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 27th 1848

Begins with fine breezes from E & clear weather course with
all sail set middle & latter part light breezes steering S by E
people employed getting rigging and so whale
Long 116 10 Lat by B. 14 10 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 28th 1848

Begins with light breezes from N.E. with passing showers of rain
steering S by E all sail set middle & latter part light with
passing showers of rain saw no whales so Ends
Long 116 34 East Lat 12 42

Remarks On Board Thursday June 29th 1848

Begins with moderate breezes from N.E. & pleasant all sail
set steering S by E, put 4 logs of board in the middle & middle &
latter part fresh breezes & passing showers employed painting
some spar so Ends
Long 116 45 East Lat 10 36

Remarks On Board Friday June 30th 1848

Begins with fresh breezes from East & pleasant with a heavy swell
running from the Southward middle part showers course S by E
at daylight we saw the land East side of the island of
Sambaba bearing N.E. 12 miles Dist from back bearing S.W. 12 miles
Dist Ends with light breeze from East and ship heading in
for the Straits with a heavy swell from Southward
employed getting anchors ready boat chains so Ends
Long 116 435 E Lat at Sun by B. 8 54 N

Remarks On Board Saturday July 1st 1848

Begins with light baffling air & calm at 3 AM saw a ship
steering in from the N.E. & a pear on the 4 AM had a breeze
from the Southward employed heading into the Straits got the anchors
and the bow overhauled 12 fathoms chain at dark 21 fathoms of
Sambaba bearing N.W. & South point of Lombok bearing West by N. the
tide setting to Southward middle part light air & calm at daylight
found ourselves 8 miles outside the Straits with calm & no current
setting Southward latter part light air from N.E. steering to
the Straits bearing N.W. people employed painting several small
jobs & ships outside of us steering in so Ends
Long of Straits E. 116 12 Lat at Sun by B. 8 58

Remarks On Board Sunday July 2nd 1848

Begins with light breezes from N.E. & pleasant steering into the
Straits at dusk saw a ship at anchor up off the town of Belli bearing
N.W. 1/2 N. about 8 miles Dist a ship at anchor entering in middle part
middle part calm at 2 PM came to anchor 2 miles to the Southward
of Belli town 28 fathoms chain out latter part light air & baffling
at 8 PM took the anchor sent up to the anchoring place had up in 14
fathoms with 40 fathoms chain out 19 miles from shore & a ship in
company & 2 merchantmen so Ends
