

Remarks On Board Saturday July 15th 1848

Commenced with strong trades from E. & S. ship heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set. watch employed ailing chains & stowing them below. at dusk brass fashions taken in light sails middle part usually single reef the topsails at daylight struck out reef. latter part more moderate Long 116 00 Lat 12 10 S

Remarks On Board Sunday July 16th 1848

Commenced with fresh trades from E. & S. ship heading W. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle part the same latter part more moderate at daylight made all sail nothing in sight Long 116 00 Lat 14 15 South

Remarks On Board Monday July 17th 1848

Commenced with fresh trades from E. & S. ship heading V. all sail set saw porpoises struck one lost him middle part the same latter part more moderate employed ailing chains & stowing them below. at dusk brass fashions taken in light sails middle part usually single reef the topsails at daylight struck out reef. latter part more moderate Long 116 00 Lat 16 20

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 18th 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from V. & E. ship heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle part the same latter part more moderate at daylight made all sail nothing in sight Long 116 00 Lat 17 20

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 19th 1848

Commenced with fine weather ship heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle part the same latter part more moderate at daylight made all sail nothing in sight Long 116 00 Lat 17 20

Remarks On Board Thursday July 20th 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from V. & E. ship heading W. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle part the same at daylight made all sail nothing in sight Long 116 00 Lat 17 20

Remarks On Board Friday July 21st 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds V. & E. ship heading E. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle part the same at daylight made all sail nothing in sight Long 116 00 Lat 17 20

Remarks On Board Saturday July 22nd 1848

Commenced with fine weather & fresh trades ship heading to the W. people employed at various jobs took out water & molasses to Enos Long 114 40 E. Lat 19 25

Remarks On Board Sunday July 23rd 1848

Throughout these 24 hours fine weather saw 2 porpoises Enos with all sail set heading W. Lat by Mrs 20 36

Remarks On Board Monday July 24th 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from V. & E. ship heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle & latter part the same employed taking down rigging blacksmithing and various other jobs to Enos saw nothing ceased to work up but did not fly him Lat 21 12

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 25th 1848

Commenced with fine weather & moderate breezes from V. & E. saw nothing at dusk double reef the topsails heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle & latter part the same saw no whales employed taking down & various jobs to Enos Lat 21 45

Long 112 36 E. Lat 21 45

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 26th 1848

Commenced with fine weather ship heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail saw 2 porpoises getting ready to put out Bow Boat on starboard side. to Enos brought to anchor Lat 22 00 Long 112 00

Remarks On Board Thursday July 27th 1848

Commenced with fine weather put out Bow Boat at dusk double reef the topsails heading V. by the wind all prudent sail set in sight middle & latter part the same at daylight made all sail saw several sulphur bottoms & fished 8 c. blacksmith at work at the forge to Enos Lat 22 45
