

Remarks On Board Friday July 28th 1848

Commenced with light breezes from O.E. ship heading to Southward & at daylight both boats lowered for them to 20 fathoms. At dusk both in sail middle part light airs from O.E. at daylight made sail heading W. & at daylight of him back lowered for them without success & 20 Ends Long 111.20. Lett 23.20.

Remarks On Board Saturday July 29th 1848

Commenced with light breezes from W.S.W. ship heading to W. at 8 A.M. made sail to W. at dusk both in sail & at daylight middle part & latter part at 10 A.M. made sail main top sail pulled forward & moderate gale from O.E. latter part the same - laying to 20 Ends Long 111.08 E. Lett 23.34

Remarks On Board Sunday July 30th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales from O.E. laying to heading to E. at dusk close reefed m. top sail & fore sail & at daylight middle part the same at daylight moderates at 5 P.M. made all. Sea steering W by S ends with fine weather Long 110.40 Lett 23.35

Remarks On Board Monday July 31st 1848

Commenced with fine weather ship heading to W. at dusk both in sail middle & latter part the same at daylight made sail & at daylight heading O.W. employed Bleaching nothing to 20 Ends Long 111.58 E. Lett by Obs 23.01

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 1st 1848

Commenced with fine weather heading O.W. at dusk both in sail middle & latter part fresh breezes at daylight single reef the topsails heading O.W. Ends the same Antonio Maryana Sick Long 109.35 E. Lett 23.46

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 2nd 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from W.E. ship heading O.W. at dusk both in sail middle & latter part moderate at daylight made all sail & at daylight heading W. & at daylight Antonio some better Long 109.20 E. Lett 23.48 by Obs 24.49

Remarks On Board Thursday Aug 3rd 1848

Commenced with light breezes from E. E. steering S.E. saw a fin back at 2 A.M. day did have him over board at dusk both in sail middle & latter part moderate gales from S.W. to N.W. at daylight both in sail at 2 A.M. in fore topsail & at dusk both in fore & latter part. Ends the same Long 109.44. Lett 24.37 Antonio Sick

Remarks On Board Friday Aug 4th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales from O.W. at dusk both in fore close reef the main middle part strong breezes with squalls latter part the same set double reef at 10 P.M. both in fore topsail 20 Ends Long 110.34 E. Lett 26.33

Remarks On Board Saturday Aug 5th 1848

Commenced with strong winds & violent squalls laying to at 4 A.M. sphere ship Varak Francis Wood master 1/2 months other. At saw Espin whole the morning middle & latter part strong breezes saw fin back at daylight made sail & at dusk ship heading W by V. Ends more moderate Long 110.23 Lett 26.44

Remarks On Board Sunday Aug 6th 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from W. at 11 A.M. saw Varak Francis lower her boats for a whole made all sail in sheer at 1 A.M. lowered for them to 20 fathoms at dusk both in sail heading W.E. the other ship got one whole middle & latter part light & baffling winds & passing showers of rain saw several fin backs ship working to the W. find by latitude this is strong weather current Long 111.10. Lett by Obs 26.24

Remarks On Board Monday Aug 7th 1848

Commenced with light baffling winds from W. heading to W. at dusk both in sail Francis in sight middle & latter part baffling at daylight made all sail steering to the W. sea & at daylight heading O.W. at dusk both in sail & at daylight heading O.W. Antonio some better Long 111.00 Lett 26.38

Remarks On Board Tuesday Aug 8th 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from W. ship heading O.W. at dusk double reef the topsails middle & latter part moderate gales & squalls from W. at 10 P.M. heading to W. both in fore topsail Antonio some better 20 Ends Long 111.08 Lett 26.48
