

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 29th 1848

Commenced with strong gales from W. with violent squalls ship
laying to under spencers heading to W. & E. middle part the same
latter part more moderate at daylight set fore & main sprail abse reef
up of W. & E. until noon then haul the head to W. commenced repairing foresail
W. Ends. Long 138° 35' 30" East Lat 35° 58' North

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 30th 1848

Commenced with fresh gales from W. with heading W. W. & N. W. in
fore sprail at dusk moderate middle part the same both in main
sprail at daylight set abse reef sprail bore up E. by S. Ends more
moderate

Lat 36° 24' N Long 129° 20' E

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 1st 1848

Commenced with fresh gales from W. with heading E. by S. under short sail
at dusk have too heading to W. & E. middle part the same steering
East at daylight set single reef sprail steering E. by S. saw nothing people
employed repairing foresail Ends more moderate

Long per chron 132° 35' East Lat by Obs 36° 23'

Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 2nd 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from W. with passing squalls of
rain steering E. by S. employed on foresail finished it bent it
at dusk took in sail steering W. & E. middle part fresh gales latter
part violent gales & squalls at 8 PM took in foresail have too heading
W. by S. at 11 took in main sprail set spencers W. Ends Breech 1 1/2 lb
Breech 2 1/2 lb of meat Long 134° 02' East per chron Lat by Obs 36° 53' N

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 3rd 1848

Commenced with violent gales from W. & N. with passing squalls at 2 AM
hoisted up lee boats which were to W. at dusk set watch heading W. & E.
with 2 spencers & staysail at middle part the same at 8 PM saw ship
headed to W. & E. Ends more moderate Long 134° 46' E Lat 37° 01' N

Remarks On Board Thursday Sept 4th 1848

Commenced with violent gales from W. & N. with passing squalls heading
to W. & E. with spencers at at 4 PM at main sprail in
middle part moderate latter part the same at daylight made sail
at 8 PM were ship heading to E. & S.

Long 134° 21' E

Lat 36° 38'

Remarks On Board Friday Sept 5th 1848

Commenced with light baffling breeze from W. & N. passing squalls saw fish
at dusk took in sail headed to W. & N. middle part calm at daylight
made sail with light air from W. & E. at 10 PM winds shifted to S. & E. Ends with light
air Long 134° 42' East Lat 36° 36' N

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 6th 1848

Commenced with light air from W. steering W. E. by S. at dusk took in
sail saw fish back middle part breezes fresh latter part fine breezes all
sail set steering W. & E. until noon watch employed a breaking out meat found
3 1/2 lb. But to be all on board 16 of Pork having consumed 22 of Beef & 2 1/2 of Pork
Ends with fine weather winds of W.

Lat 37° 41' N Long 136° 03' E

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 10th 1848

Commenced with fine breezes from N. W. steering to E. at 4 AM saw
2 whales going E. suppose them to be Right whales at dusk took in sail aboard
ship heading N. W. middle part. saw ship with light air from W. & E. at
daylight made sail steered to the S. & E. saw nothing so Ends

Long per chron 136° 28' E Lat by Obs 37° 41' N

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 11th 1848

Commenced with light air from W. steering to S. & E. until 4 PM saw
nothing at dusk took in sail headed to W. & N. with light air from W. & N.
middle part winds shifted to W. & N. steered W. E. at daylight made sail
saw nothing so Ends Long 137° 50' E Lat 38° 17'

Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 12th 1848

Commenced with fresh breeze from N. W. & other weather steering W. E. at 1 PM
saw 2 shoals of Blackfish headed & took 3 of them at dusk took in sail have
too heading to W. & N. middle part fine weather
at daylight made  sail steered W. E.
employed boiling out Blackfish tarred up 4 bbls so Ends Long 138° 00' Lat 38° 47' N

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 13th 1848

Commenced with fine weather winds N. W. steering W. E. at dusk took in
middle & latter part some foggy at daylight made sail & saw 1 1/2 E. saw
nothing Ends thick fog

Lat Bad Obs 39° 38' N

Long per chron 138° 16' E
