

# Remarks On Board Thursday Sept 14th 1845

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. with passing fog clearing by E. at dusk took in fore & top sail close reef main cleared off & set Boats for Dye middle part the same latter part wind more brisk at daylight made out at 11 AM wind shifted to W.W. could reef the top sail. No Ends

# Remarks On Board Friday Sept 15th 1845

Commenced with strong breezes from S.W. with present sail set heading S.E. by the wind saw North whale porpoises at dusk took in sail  middle & latter part strong gales with squalls from W.W. ship lying to close reef main top sail & fore sail. No Ends

# Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 16th 1845

Commenced with strong gales from W.W. with passing squalls lying to heading to S.E. with close reef main top sail & fore sail at dusk took in main top sail at watch middle part the same latter part moderate at daylight made sail heading to S.E. at 9 shook out reefs set main top gallant sail & c. Ends gave men one glass of brandy & stout

# Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 17th 1845

Commenced with moderate breezes from W.W. with passing squalls steering N.E. at dusk took in sail middle part the same latter part strong breezes heading to Southward at daylight set single reef top sail courses & jib saw nothing Ends more moderate winds W.W. ship heading East

Long per chron 141 34 Lat by Obs 42 56 N

# Remarks On Board Monday Sept 18th 1845

Commenced with strong breezes from W.W. heading to S.E. saw finbacks at dusk took in sail middle part the same latter part aimed S.E. at daylight made all sail at 1 PM boat & ship heading to W.W. by the wind looked for a school of Whales without success. No Ends

# Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 19th 1845

Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. heading to S.E. by the wind saw finbacks at dusk took in sail middle part thick & rainy latter part fine weather at daylight made all sail heading S.E. with little S.E. Ends the same

Long per chron 142 45 E Lat by Obs 43 30 N

# Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 20th 1845

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. & cloudy all sail set heading S.E. by the wind at 7 AM commenced standing head watches wind enlivened to S.W. steering by 1/2 mile to latter part light breezes from East at daylight backed to S.E. saw nothing Ends calm in getting to latitude observed a black spot in the upper limb of the sun

Lat 44 07 N Long 143 30 E

# Remarks On Board Thursday Sept 21st 1845

Commenced with calm & pleasant breeze from S.W. heading S.E. by the wind saw nothing. No Ends

# Remarks On Board Friday Sept 22nd 1845

Commenced with light winds from S.E. & cloudy all sail set heading by the wind to S.E. at dusk took in light sails wind head to S.E. middle part latter part the same saw a finback ship heading S.W. No Ends

Lat 45 20 Long 145 07 E

# Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 23rd 1845

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. & cloudy weather ship head S.W. by the wind at 2 PM could reef the top sail middle part the same took in main sail jib fore & top sail at daylight set fore top sail Ends with passing fog & rain Broke a cask of Bread & 1 barrel of Flour saw Blackfish

# Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 24th 1845

Commenced with light airs from S.E. with fog & ship head to W.W. at dusk took in sail close reef main top sail sent down main top gallant yard middle & latter light baffling airs from S.E. to W.W. at daylight set fore sail took in main part cleared out quarter Boats were ship to S.W. made Ends with rain & fog Long by chron Projection 145 38 E Lat by Projection 46 11 N

# Remarks On Board Monday Sept 25th 1845

Commenced with light winds from S.W. with rain & fog at 4 AM were ship head to W.W. heading to W at dusk took in fore sail & top sail Barometer very low down to 29.5 has done at that for 8 hours middle part moderate breezes from West steering S.E. by S. latter part the same at daylight set double reef top sail at 10 PM shook out reef Ends the same broke out provision & small stoves Barometer at 29.75 Long per chron 146 43 Lat by Obs 47 40
