

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct. 26th 1848

Commenced with fine weather wind S.W. employed cutting sperm whale
finishes at dusk with catch commenced belching middle & latter part fine saw
& light whale bones for them to disappear so ends

Let 38 22.0 Long 151.54 E

Remarks On Board Friday Oct. 27th 1848

Commenced with fine weather wind S.W. employed belching & clearing light whale
at dusk took in sail middle and latter part moderate gales from S.W.
saw 2 whales brought a barrel of flour so ends

Let 38 04.0

Long 151 27 8

Remarks On Board Saturday Oct 28th 1848

Commenced with moderate gales from S.W. & cloudy employed belching
at 11 AM short ship heading E.S.E. with close reef main & foresail
middle & latter part fine weather at 9 AM finished belching whale
turned up 65 lbs & sail in sight at 10 AM saw 11 whales to the S.E.
ran for them until 4 PM so ends Long 151.50 Let 38.14

Remarks On Board Sunday Oct. 29th 1848

Commenced with fine weather saw 2 numbers of light whale bones 2 times
at dusk turned over up got him along side at dusk taken in sail at dusk
middle & latter part cloudy & moderate & sail in
sight at daylight commenced cutting finished at 10 AM
at dusk finished down so ends

Remarks On Board Monday Nov. 30th 1848

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.W. thick with rain employed
stowing down sperm fat down all but one gash spoke Barth George Chamber
of soap & 2 numbers at 2300 lbs middle part thunder & lightning and rain got ready
for gale middle & latter part violent gale from N.W. tried to bail but
could not take in main & fore so ends

Let 37 40 Long 152.04

Remarks On Board Tuesday Oct 31st 1848

Commenced with violent gales at dusk moderate started by works & sail
in sight heading to N.W. passing squalls of wind & rain middle part the same
latter part moderate at daylight made all sail saw fin back &
sail in sight one whale lying under head to north

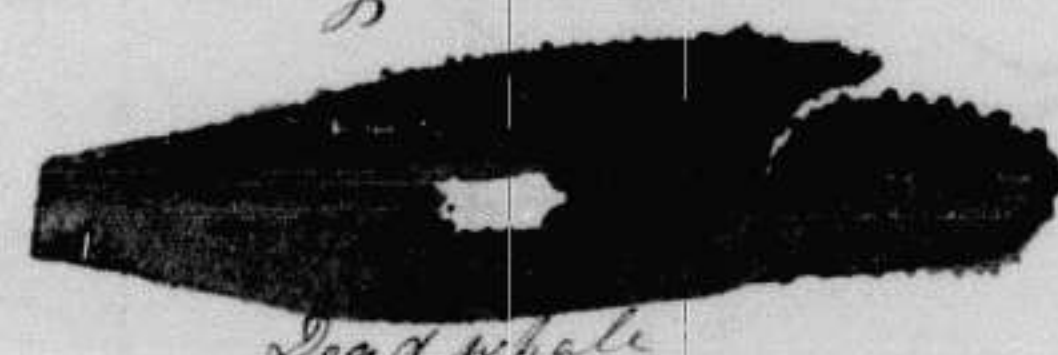

Remarks On Board Wednesday November 1st 1848

Commenced with fresh breeze from S.W. & clearing O.W. at 2 PM took in sail
at 4 have to heading N.W. employed belching middle part the same
fresh gale latter part variable made sail at 10 PM took in employed belching
& stowing down saw 2 whales so ends Long 151.52 E Let 37 12.0

Remarks On Board Thursday Nov. 2nd 1848

Commenced with fine weather clearing till 4 AM short sail finished
belching at dusk whale turned up 105 lbs middle & latter part light wind & clear
at daylight made all sail commenced stowing down at 10 PM saw 2 dead whale
light whale took him along side commenced cutting finished so ends

Remarks On Board Friday Nov 2nd 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading to N.W. employed belching
& stowing down middle part changeable weather wind S.W.
latter part fine weather finished belching & cleared up saw 12 light whales to
northward 10 PM saw 2 whales turned up with Let 37 58 Long 152.54

Remarks On Board Saturday Nov 4th 1848

Commenced with fine weather wind O.W. heading O.W. saw light whale at 4 PM
lowered for him to do purpose at dusk took in sail middle & latter part
moderate gales saw 2 whales finished stowing down heading to N.W.

Remarks On Board Sunday Nov 5th 1848

Commenced with strong wind from N.W. & squally heading to Westward under
short sail Bree out mist & fog cleared up decks at dusk took in sail
middle & latter part fine weather saw one light whale lowerd for him with
out success at dusk took in sail head so ends Let 38 06 Long 152.07

Remarks On Board Monday Nov 6th 1848

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. evening saw 2 whales at
dusk took in sail heading to N.W. middle & latter part moderate
gales saw fin back so ends

Let 38 20 Long 151.30 E
