

Remarks On Board Saturday Dec. 24. 1848

Commenced with fine weather and light breeze from E. at 10 AM. took in fore topsail & latter part fine breeze from E. at daylight main all sail steered S.E. and nothing to Endeavour Long 163° 45' East Lat 41° 45' North

Remarks On Board Sunday Dec. 25. 1848

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. & cloudy & steered up V. by W. saw nothing at 1 PM. single reef the topsails & set main & fore all sail commenced standing round watered middle part squally, double reef winds shifted to

N.W. latter part passing squalls & took out reef heading S.E.

Remarks On Board Monday Dec. 26. 1848

Began with passing squalls & fresh breeze heading to S. at 6 PM. saw D sail to windward. middle part & latter part calm on sea in sight Long 167° 10' Lat 41° 05'

Remarks On Board Tuesday Dec. 27. 1848

Commenced with light air from S. spoke Bark Panther - middle part the same latter part fresh breeze & hazy weather steering W. saw nothing to Endeavour Long 166° 17' E. Lat 41° 46' took out reef

Remarks On Board Wednesday Dec. 28. 1848

Commenced with strong & rather violent winds accompanied with rain at 4 PM. double reef the topsails steering W. at 8 took in fore topsail middle & latter part fresh gales at 9 PM. set double reef topsails & made more moderate steering N.W. & saw fresh breeze Lat 42° 48' Long 164° 52'

Remarks On Board Thursday Dec. 29. 1848

Commenced with strong winds from N.W. & steering N.W. at 4 PM. severe rain took in main sail fore topsail at 5 AM. shifted to W. close reef main & topsail furled fore sail middle part fresh gales & squalls middle & latter part the same at 11 AM. found the mainmast to be very rotten about 9 feet above the deck got ready to send down mainmast to Endeavour Lat 43° 31' Long 164° 35' East

Remarks On Board Friday Dec. 30. 1848

Commenced with moderate gale from N.W. & set sail sent down mainmast & fore & top gallant yards weather ship heading N.W. & middle & latter part strong winds & passing squalls all prudent sail steering N.W. by V. Long 163° 45' East Lat 44° 14'

Remarks On Board Saturday Dec. 31. 1848

Commenced with strong breezes from N.W. & passing squalls all prudent sail set heading to V. W. saw great many birds at 6 PM. took in fore topsail close reef main middle & latter part variable weather making & taking in sail as occasion requires Endeavour steering N.W. by V. Lat 45° 13' V. Long 163° 39' E.

Remarks On Board Sunday Dec. 1. 1849

Commenced with fresh gales & passing squalls from S.W. at 4 PM. took in sail close reef fore & top sails at 6 took in main topsail has been up to boat middle & latter part variable at 10 AM. set the topsails double reef steered N.W. & saw nothing to Endeavour Lat 45° 56' V. Long 163° 30' E.

Remarks On Board Monday Dec. 2. 1849

Commenced with strong winds from N.W. steering N.W. & saw nothing to Endeavour took in sail heading to N.W. middle & latter part fresh gales run off to S.E. & Endeavour Lat 46° 28' Long 164° 32' E.

Remarks On Board Tuesday Dec. 3. 1849

Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. & have to head to N.W. saw nothing middle & latter part the same at 7 AM. took in fore topsail in main topsail winds shifted to N.W. with lightning & hard squalls at 9 AM. took a sea on our starboard fore chains & fore bulwarks hurt one man & young man boat cleav'd Endeavour with squalls heading North Long 164° 26' East Lat 46° 44' North

Remarks On Board Wednesday Dec. 4. 1849

Commenced with violent gales from N.W. with squalls of wind & hail & heavy sea running took in W. Boat took out mast & latter at dusk heading to S. middle & latter part fresh gales & mostly cloudy Endeavour heading to V. Lat 46° 39' Long 164° 33'

Remarks On Board Thursday Dec. 5. 1849

Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. laying to set main topsail mast took at 6 PM. saw ship head to W. & took in main topsail took a weather middle part the same the same

Latter part fine breeze from N.W. at day by by made sail head out water at 6 AM. bore up S.E. saw fresh breeze to Endeavour Long 164° 36' Lat 46° 42' E.
