Commenced with fine weather wind V^l E heading to E. saw nothing
at dusk took in sail middle & latter part calm employed painting
waterways so Ends Copper No Better

Commenced with calm saw sulphur bottoms sheered them at dusk took in
sail middle & latter part fine weather wind V^l E at daylight made
sail steering V^l E by E saw Killers so Ends Lett 35.41

Remarks On Board Sunday Jan 14th 1849

Commenced with fine weather wind West steering V^l E at dusk took
in sail middle & latter part fresh breeze from V^l E at daylight
made all prudent sail steering to V^l E by the wind saw
nothing so Ends copper the same

Commenced with fresh breeze from V^l E heading to V^l at dusk took in sail
middle & latter part fine saw nothing employed making paddles for all the boats
copper some better so Ends Lett 35.44 Long 168.30

Remarks On Board Tuesday Jan 16th 1849

Commenced with fine weather wind V^l E heading to V^l at dusk took in sail
middle & latter part fine at daylight made all sail
saw No whales took 2 Lunar Obs saw great quantities of floating
shells & jellys in the water ship steering to V^l E

Commenced with fine weather wind N.W. steering N.E. at dusk took in
sail middle & latter part fine saw nothing so Ends heading to V^l E

Remarks On Board Thursday Jan 18th 1849

Commenced with fine weather wind N.W. heading to E at 2.00 pm
saw the Land heading E N E saw 2 sail ships one Bark Pembroke
of New London 600 tons at dusk took in sail steered V^l E.

middle & latter part the same steering to V^l saw sulphur bottoms

Breeze in light Ends with 2 shifts of wind to V^l?

Remarks On Board Friday Jan 19th 1849

Commenced with light breeze from South heading cloudy at dusk
took in sail headed to V^l middle & latter part variable weather much
huffing cruising saw nothing copper no better Long 17.20 Lett 36.15 V

Remarks On Board Saturday Jan 20th 1849

Commenced with light huffing wind from N.E. thick smoky weather
at dusk took in sail heading E N middle & latter part the same
at daylight made sail pembroke in sight saw nothing at dusk
tacked ship heading N.W. so Ends copper some better
